

Directions to Borough Park Fields / Waldwick Police Training Facility
GPS ADDRESS: 7 Pine Street, Waldwick NJ 07463, Then Continue Into Park and You Will End at Facility

FROM RT. 17 SOUTH

Exit Rt. 17 at Sheridan Ave and stay right to the center of town.
Turn left at the light onto Franklin Turnpike.
Go one block and turn right onto Wyckoff Ave.
Go past the Stop & Shop, over bridge and just past the light.
Turn right onto Hopper Ave, just before Waldwick HS.
Continue on Hopper Ave to Pennington Ave.
Turn left onto Pennington Ave and slowly proceed to the end of the street.
At the end of Pennington, turn right into Borough Park.

FROM RT. 17 NORTH

Exit Rt. 17 at Hollywood Ave.
Turn left thru the island and onto Hollywood Ave for Ho-Ho-Kus.
Stay on Hollywood Ave, over Rt. 17, thru one traffic light and to the blinking light at the top of the hill.
Turn right onto Franklin Tpke.
At first light, turn left onto Wyckoff Ave.
Go past the Stop & Shop, over bridge and just past the light.
Turn right onto Hopper Ave, just before Waldwick HS.
Continue on Hopper Ave to Pennington Ave.
Turn left onto Pennington Ave and slowly proceed to the end of the street.
At the end of Pennington, turn right into Borough Park.

FROM THE EAST

Take Old Hook Rd to the center of Westwood.
Turn left onto Washington Ave.
Stay on Washington Ave for several miles; pass over the Garden State
Parkway and over the hill.
Then bear right (staying on Rt. 502) onto East Saddle River Rd.
Make the 2nd left onto Hollywood Ave.
Stay on Hollywood Ave, over Rt. 17, thru one traffic light and to the blinking light at the top of the hill.
Turn right onto Franklin Tpke.
At first light, turn left onto Wyckoff Ave.
Go past the Stop & Shop, over bridge and just past the light.
Turn right onto Hopper Ave, just before Waldwick HS.
Continue on Hopper Ave to Pennington Ave.
Turn left onto Pennington Ave and slowly proceed to the end of the street.
At the end of Pennington, turn right into Borough Park.

FROM THE WEST

Starting from the center of Wyckoff
(Franklin Ave. from Oakland or Rt. 287 onto Rt. 208 South, exit Ewing Ave, go left, then right onto Franklin Ave.)
Continue on Franklin Ave into Waldwick (Changes to Wyckoff Ave.)
Just past the Waldwick HS field and before the traffic light, turn left onto Hopper Ave.
Continue on Hopper Ave to Pennington Ave.
Turn left onto Pennington Ave and slowly proceed to the end of the street.
At the end of Pennington, turn right into Borough Park.

FROM RIDGEWOOD/MIDLAND PARK

Starting from Lincoln Ave.
Turn right onto Godwin Ave.
At the light, turn left onto Monroe Ave.
Continue on Monroe Ave for several miles—all the way until the end.
Turn left onto Wyckoff Ave.
Turn right onto Hopper Ave, just before Waldwick HS.
Continue on Hopper Ave to Pennington Ave.
Turn left onto Pennington Ave and slowly proceed to the end of the street.
At the end of Pennington, turn right into Borough Park.
