7th Annual Alaska "A" Wood Bat Tournament

July 9ththrough July 12th2015 at Oberg and Loretta French Fields

Rules and Comments

- **Time Limit-** No inning shall start after 2 hours and 15 minutes, except for Championship Game.
- No pitcher will pitch more than 10 innings in tournament
- **Illegal Players** There will be allowed only 3 crossover players from a program's Form 1 that will be eligible to play in tournament
- Official Baseball Rules; DH for the pitcher only. No re-entry and No courtesy runners
- **Dugouts** Home dugout is 1st Base dugout. No switching dugouts after double headers. Next team takes open dugout regardless if they are home or visitor.
- **Oberg/Loretta French batting cages** No cleats allowed in cages, please take trash with you. No sunflower seeds at Loretta French
- **Pregame-** Teams can take pregame as time allows. As soon as the field is ready, home team has option to take field for a max of 8 minutes. Split allowable time evenly. All pregame must be finished 5 minutes before start of game
- **Bats** Wood or a Baum/Rawlings composite bat. Tournament official/director has final say on any questionable bats. Chugiak will furnish at least a 32" and 33" wood composite bat for each team. Bats must be left at home plate at end of game.
- **Home team** is listed second on game schedule.
- Every team will play a minimum of 4 games. Each team is obligated to play the games per league rules. If a team forfeits the game, any punishments, will be handed down by the league.
- **Tie Breaking rules**: 1.) Most wins 2.) Least Runs Allowed 3.) Net Run Differential 4.) Highest Runs Quotient: Runs For/Runs Against 5.) Coin flip
- **Ejections** Any ejected player/coach must go to the parking lot. The player/coach will miss one additional game and any further games will be left to the decision of the Tournament director(s). Ejected player/coach will need to meet with tournament director(s) before further play.
- **Team MVP** One player from each team in the tournament will receive an ash wood bat.
- A Tournament MVP will be awarded a maple wood bat.
- Any questions on final ruling and appeals will be handled by the Tournament Director(s).

- Weather delays/cancellations will fall to the tournament director(s) to reschedule games of highest priority to make the best of the 4 day tournament
