CREEKVIEW BASEBALL - LETTERING POLICY

General Requirements

All Creekview High School students will be given the opportunity to earn a letter jacket / letter by participation in baseball. The following system will enable students/athletes (including managers and statisticians) to be rewarded for their loyalty and hard work during their high school career as well as for their athletic ability in baseball.

Varsity Letter

Any member of the VARSITY baseball team may earn a varsity letter through hard work, dedication and meeting various criteria established by the head coach. Players must adhere to all Cherokee County, school and team rules and regulations, including academic requirements, GHSAA rules, training rules, practice requirements, and any other requirements established by the head coach.

In order to earn a varsity letter for baseball at Creekview a player must meet <u>AT LEAST ONE</u> of the following categories:

- Appear in at least 50% of all games played (participation in baseball will include activities such as
 a pinch-runner, courtesy-runner, pinch-hitter, bullpen catcher <u>OR</u> other contributions as defined
 by the head coach.)
- Have at least 26 total plate appearances (this would include walks, hit-by-pitch, etc.)
- Play 40 innings defensively
- Have seven pitching appearances
- Pitch at least 20.0 innings
- Any pitcher with four or more decisions
- Managers may letter after one season if they perform their duties.
- Statisticians may letter after two seasons if they perform their duties.

Loss of Lettering Eligibility

Any athlete that is removed from eligible participation in baseball as a result of discipline, academic, legal, personal choice or parental measures may lose his/her privilege to letter in that activity if they do not stay in good standing with the team and/or coach.
