2017 Concession Stand Agreement

Concession Duty Coverage Agreement

The concession stand is very important in meeting our park budget. Meeting this budget is vital in keeping the registration costs as low as possible. Donelson Baseball (DB) strives to be fair to its members and players. While the coaches are volunteer positions, each parent/guardian is also an active member for DB. While we understand that concession stand duty is an additional task for each of us, DB would not be able to effectively provide coverage without volunteer support.

In an effort to effectively provide coverage for the concession stand, the following is understood and has been explained to me:

Each player must be represented in the concession stand during the team's scheduled duty. This will be a minimum of 4 ½ hours. If the games are rescheduled for weather then the concession duty will also be rescheduled. Your team will work a maximum of 2 times during the season. Each team will be required to have 7 people to work during the assigned time. The manager or team mom will coordinate the shift assignments. When entering the concession stand the representative is required to sign in. It is preferred that the representative work the entire shift as it is difficult to train workers multiple times throughout the shift.

Each registered player is required to have one representative, to work the concession stand. The player representative may opt out for a fee of \$50. This fee will cover the cost to hire a replacement worker for that one assigned shift, for that player representative.

If you do not opt out and do not show up for an assigned shift, then the player will not be allowed to participate in games until a \$50 fine is paid. A understaffed concession stand ultimately affects the budget and must be taken seriously.
