Baseball Boosters Meeting Minutes – Aug. 17, 2011

Meeting began at 6:35 pm

Minutes: A change to the 5/11/11 minutes was made. Clint Sparks was voted in as VP before the banquet in June by the existing officers. Doug Werner made a motion to accept the minutes with changes made and Shelley Merkin second the motion.

Treasurers Report: Report is attached for May – Aug. it is not balanced and will not be approved until Paul reviews and makes needed changes. ? deposit of \$130.24 in June was for Ken Werner. Community service fundraiser check was given to Coach Reynolds. Current balance is closer to around \$15,500.

Coaches Report: Coach Reynolds thanked the boosters for all that was done last year. Fall workouts will start after Labor Day. He met with the Athletic Director which is Don Stonefield, regarding new uniforms. It was suggested that instead of purchasing shoes with the spirit pack, they will include a pair of game pants. The players would keep their pants and could rewear them from year to year. Discussed with Athletic Dir. to purchase high end jerseys and maybe boosters would purchase alternate jersey. They would pass down the current jerseys. Shoes would be made available to purchase or purchase individually as long as they were black and white. Athletic Dept. is looking to do 3 season all sports program instead of individual sports doing their own. Hendricks is cracking down on fundraisers. Community service would have to go through the school. We would be required to fill out paperwork for the school. Concessions were discussed. The cookouts are cutting into the concessions revenue. Need to look at ways in increase revenue at the games with concessions and attendance. Discussed maybe having the youth programs recognized at a home game or maybe scheduling the games later in the evening to increase attendance. Louisville Slugger asked the HS players to demonstrate bats on Sat. @ 10 am at Jennings County.

Old Business: Kroger card income has dropped off a little. Send out a reminder to keep using the cards all year long. It needs to be discussed at a later meeting the payout for the card use through Dec. or start over/cut off in Oct. Last year's fundraisers were discussed. Need to look at what to keep or change or stop doing. What are our needs going to be next year. Windscreen – has this been paid for? According to Mark S, Sue says it has not been paid for. The school paid Kesslers and we paid the school. We have the cancelled check and will look into who endorsed the check. Brick dust on JV field – do we still need? We would need to purchase 5-8 ton and put down in the fall. Check with Tom T on pricing from Casey's. Doug W will work on putting the minutes on the website. Boosters would like to offer a 1 time Scholarship Award to a graduating senior. Reynolds will check with Stonefield.

Grant – no update; senior night – no update; survey results – Laura will compile results and send them out; banquet – reimbursement from EC for each player/coach who attended. Laura will turn the # into the school.

New Business: We will discuss at the Sept. meeting the 2012 Budget and 2011 Spending Summary. Keys to the press box...who has keys, who needs to return and who needs keys? There should be 12 keys out there. Field Maintenance day will be Sat. Oct 29th 9 a.m. rain out date Nov. 5th. Need to make a "to do" list. Portable Backstop – Reynolds believes practice would be more organized; it would be used by all 3 EC teams but not used by other groups. Reynolds would like to move the fence and add a gate. He will check with Stonefield. Would like it to be collapsible and cover with a tarp in the winter. Laura recommended buying a

new one vs. a used one and will research cost. (around \$3000) Dan W found a used one in Chicago for \$500. He will find out more and see if they will set it up completely and send pictures before deciding. It was also said that the JV field fencing is in bad shape and needs work/replace.

Reynolds made a purchase from Louisville Slugger for 2 sets of catchers gear, 4 training bats, 20 sets of batting gloves, 3 BB Core bats and received 2 free BB Core bats. The top 20 players who collected the most money from the community service drive will receive the batting gloves. Any money left will go towards field improvements. He is making a wish list to present to the board soon. The portable batting cage was picked up and is being used. It is working out great and was a good purchase.

Old Business: We need administrators for upcoming fundraisers. Let Laura W know what you would like to help with. Doug W met with Fencecraft regarding putting up a fence/gate for the portable batting cage and work on the JV fence. The man has not gotten back with a quote. A gate is needed but no fencing around the backstop. Brick dust .. Tom T said that Knigga was the highest price. Mark S knows where we have gotten it in the past. The website has been upgraded. We can post the minutes and agenda on it. Doug W did some web research for Scholarship Awards. He will meet with Donnie S to discuss doing this. Sue D would like to apply for the Whitewater Valley Grant. It is due Oct. 10. She is showing the need to improve the JV fields for safety and the use of an L Screen. It was discussed who has keys and who needs one. Clint S needs a key and some keys need to be returned. It was found in previous records that the grill was purchased ½ by baseball boosters and ½ by football boosters. It is currently being used by the football boosters. Field Maintenance Day – Doug and Coach Reynolds need to make a list and email reminders need to be sent out and include the freshman players that we have contact info. on. Insurance liability waiver – Clint will get with Chris Wilson to find out if a waiver needs to be signed when do community service or work by the players/parents. Treasurers Report: Current balance is \$15,932.38. Kroger check was added since last meeting and a check written for the brick dust. Laura W. gave Paul a check for \$1000 from the Whitewater Valley REMC. This grant is given out quarterly. Try to get more Kroger cards out to potential freshman so Paul will purchase 20 more cards. Motion to approve the treasurer report was made by Clint S and second by Laura S.

Coaches Report: Coach thanked everyone who helped on field day. There was a good turnout and we got a lot done. There will be no baseball activity in Nov. and Dec. Coach Reynolds will email his wish list and prioritize it for the board by next meeting.

Fundraisers: Clint will be in charge of the flower sales. We will talk to Weber's Greenhouse in Sunman and Casey's in Bright. Do they prefer/recommend offering flats and/or gift certificates? Doug W will be in charge of the Golf Tournament. He has reserved Brookhill Golf Course for May 20, 2012. Laura S will be in charge of the Cornhole Tournament as long as we can find someone to borrow the cornhole sets from. Someone will check with Jeff Bossey. We probably don't need to get as many sets as last year. Coach Reynolds will get approval from the school for the Community Service Project.

Sharon will check with the SDYAA and SASA on the One Call system that they use.

All of the keys have been returned with the exception of possibly one with Shorty Grubbs. Laura W will follow up and send me a list of who has keys currently for the records.

In looking at the finance report, it was questioned why the net profit is so high on the player packs. We should not be making any profit on these items. Paul will look into and report back.

Continued field maintenance: Doug W will look into gravel costs, fixing the fence on the JV field, fixing the poles and painting the fence and possibly draining the outfield on the JV field. Laura W checked on pricing of gravel from New Point Stone for the walkway on both fields, dugout area on both fields and JV warning track.

Uniforms: Laura W checked into the boosters purchasing a second jersey for the Varsity for away games and/or doubleheaders. She contacted Art with Russell. The lightweight jersey

would be around \$950 plus tax and the heavier weight jersey would be around \$1300 plus tax. We would purchase 25 tops. We decided to table the purchase until we can see the quality of the uniforms and see where it is prioritized on the wish list.

It was suggested and agreed upon to purchase a laptop for the boosters' organization to maintain all of the records and to stay with the boosters' org. Laura W will look into purchasing with a budget around \$300.

Coach Reynolds made a donation of \$100 to Soldier Bret Bondurant of Lawrenceburg for medical expenses on behalf of ECHS baseball.

Dan W recommended that the budget report shows where we will now have payouts for the Kroger cards in June and Dec.

The December meeting will be changed to Tues. Dec. 20 per the request of Coach Reynolds.
