The Cornshucker Baseball Club, Inc. is a recognized non-profit 501 (c) (3) organization dedicated to providing valuable life-learning opportunities to our community's young people through the game of baseball.

2015 Spring Baseball Details

- **Season options include:**
 - 12 or 18 game season.
 - Teams matched up based on level of competitiveness if possible
 - Additional games beyond 12 or 18 game season can be added.
 - Schedule flexibility. Teams play games on weekends. Games can be played during week, but facility and another team must be available. In 2015, teams with 18 game season will play at least three Sat-Sun weekends.
 - Spring baseball coordinator may try to schedule mini-tourney formats on some weekends for teams interested.
- Teams play doubleheaders. Each game is seven innings with no new inning after 1:40. This helps to limit innings for pitchers early in season and keeps games moving. Games will not end in ties.
- Rain dates scheduled throughout the season when possible and May 9-10.
- Iowa High School Athletic Association (IAHSAA) 2015 Rules will be enforced.
- IAHSAA licensed umpires used.
- Continuous batting order and free defensive substitutions allowed, except for pitcher.
- Score is kept for games and all teams receive USSSA points for participation.
- League fee covers umpire, facility use, baseballs and player shirts.
- Each team is responsible for providing coaches, scorekeepers and all other baseball equipment. Coaches must be over 18 years of age.
- All registrations must be submitted at same time if registering as a team. Teams must submit one check as individual players' checks for a team will not be accepted. (A return check fee of \$75.00 will be assessed for all team or individual returned checks.)
- **Refund Policy:** Teams guaranteed that they will play 2/3 of scheduled games (12 game season — 8 games and 18 game season — 12 games). Partial refund applies if teams play less than guaranteed games. Refunds issued to high school baseball program of participant. Teams choosing not to make-up games not eligible for refund policy.

PLEASE NOTE: Efforts will be made to schedule teams around potential conflicts. However, conflicts need to be communicated to coordinator by March 11, 2015. No exceptions!
