- 3. Practice start time = the time we expect each player to be on the field ready to go, not coming out to the field

Equipment

- 2. Players must have white and grey pants with blue piping (Varsity), royal blue belt, blue socks for games (JV)
- 3. Grey pants, blue belt and their practice shirt for every practice at all levels.
- 4. Players must have some type of athletic / turf shoe for strength & conditioning, batting cages, etc. These need to be worn to and from the field everyday (games and practices).
