BoyzABC (Boys Against Breast Cancer) is excited to announce the inaugural HOME RUN DERBY on Saturday May 14th, jointly sponsored with Tam Baseball. BoyzABC is a not profit organization founded by a small group of Mill Valley Middle School boys in 2012, after one of our moms was diagnosed with advanced breast cancer. As many of you know, 1 in 8 woman in the US will be diagnosed with Breast Cancer (240,000 new cases every year), and woman in Marin County may be particularly vulnerable. Of those women, 40,000 will die from their disease; 1 out of 6 diagnosed. It is the most common cancer in women and the second leading cause of cancer deaths in women. New research has led to great strides in the diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of this devastating disease. However, Breast Cancer remains one of the most significant woman's health problems. To this end, we joined forces with several of our Mill Valley friends to form **BoyzABC** in order to raise money for breast cancer research. The previous three years, BoyzABC has held an annual March Madness Free Throw Shooting fundraiser that many of you have participated in. These efforts have raised tens of thousands of dollars that have been donated to the UCSF Helen Diller Family Comprehensive Cancer Center, a world leader in Breast Cancer Research. This year, **BoyzABC** has joined forces with **Tam Baseball** for a special HOME RUN DERBY to be held Saturday May 14th at Noon, at the Tam High Baseball Field. KNBR's Brian Murphy will MC the opening ceremonies. Half of all proceeds raised will be donated to the UCSF Helen Diller Family Comprehensive Cancer Center (Dr. Hope Rugo Breast Cancer Research Program). The other half will be donated to Tam Baseball, and will be designated to the renovation and enclosure of the Tam batting cages, a project that will benefit all Mill Valley Baseball and Softball Players.

#### The format will be as follows:

Each participating player will gather sponsors that will pledge to donate either a fixed amount, or an amount dependent upon the number of home runs hit (see sponsor sheet attached). The player will come to the derby with their sponsor sheet filled out and be assigned to an **age-appropriate fence**. Each player will get an opportunity to hit as many home runs as possible before recording 10 outs (any ball that does not go over the fence is counted as an out). A special **pink** ball will be used as the 10<sup>th</sup> out, and all **pink** ball homeruns hit will count double. Once the number of home runs hit has been calculated, the player can then collect their donations. All donations are tax deductible; checks should be made out to **BoyzABC**.

Corporate sponsors can also give a fixed amount as follows: Platinum Sponsor: \$1,000 Gold Sponsor: \$500 Silver Sponsor: \$250 Bronze Sponsor: \$100

Children and adults can help by being either a derby participant and/or derby volunteer.
