Again this year will be a camp MVP Award given to one boy and one girl voted by the coaches as camp MVP of both the boy’s week and girl’s week.

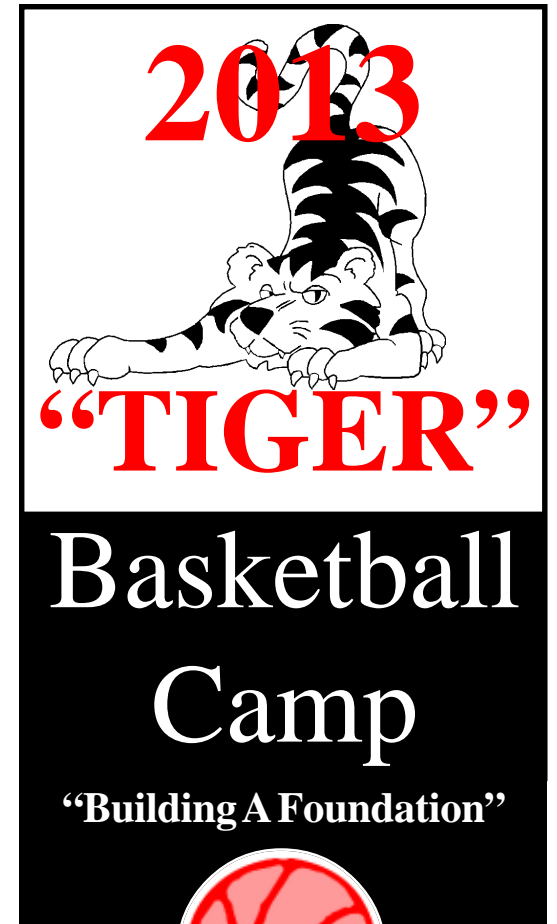
Attention All 8th Grade Player!

“TIGER” Basketball Camp is for every player; beginner, intermediate, and advanced who wants to become a better basketball player. The camp’s objective is to provide the best possible instruction to all players by teaching the fundamentals of the game at the various levels in the manner of good sportsmanship and safety.

The camp will be limited to the first 150 applicants for each week and will run from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM each day, Monday through Friday.

Our camp will include breakfast and lunch each day. Each participant will receive a **FREE** “Tiger” Basketball camp T-shirt and a **FREE** regulation size basketball. A special family BBQ, included in the camp price, will be held on Friday for all campers and family for the presentation of awards.

Players will be grouped by age and ability into three divisions: High School, College, and NBA/WNBA and will have 5 indoor courts plus outdoor courts available to use. The High School division will use shorter baskets and smaller balls while the College and NBA/WNBA divisions will use regulation baskets and balls. The High School division will learn the basics of beginning basketball while the College division will be drilled extensively on fundamentals and team play. Both divisions will play two games a day. The NBA/WNBA division will have a heavy concentration on shooting techniques, offensive moves, defense and rebounding while also playing two games a day.

The camp will provide each player with an opportunity to develop his or her basketball skills through drills, games, films, and lectures while offering a competitive and fun atmosphere.

Program Features

- *A daily system of stations that teach basic skills and concepts
- *Skill work in all aspects of the game

- *Two games per day
- *Individual Contests

SKILLS CONTEST: This is a series of timed skills involving shooting, passing and dribbling through a skills course similar to that used at the NBA All-Star Weekend. We are sure that all the camp participants will enjoy this new feature.

Director

Larry Gardner has been the director of the “Tiger” Basketball Camp since its inception back in the 80’s. Coach Gardner began his varsity-coaching career in 1980 as the boys varsity coach and built a successful program resulting in two Eastern Maine Class C Championships. He founded the “Tiger Cubs” ball handling team that performed for tens of thousands of people across the State including performances with the Harlem Globetrotters.

Gardner returned in 1998 to coach the girl’s varsity basketball team. In his fifteen years as girl’s coach, his teams made 15 tournament appearances including State Champions in 2010. This season, Gardner earned his 300th career win. Gardner coached the McDonald’s East West C/D All-Star team in 1998 and again in 2010. He has been named the Girls Class D Coach of the Year in 2009 and 2010.

Camp Fees

The price of the camp is \$125.00 and includes the camp instruction, meals, awards, camp T-shirt and camp basketball as well as our ending “Family Barbecue” awards. A \$10.00 discount is available for those families sending more than one player to either the girls or boys week.
