GASO roundup: Rim Rockers get big win

BRYAN - In the AAU basketball world, there's still a place for fundamentals. Just ask the Rim Rockers.

A team based out of central Texas, the Rim Rockers pulled the biggest stunner of the Bryan/College Station Great American Shoot-Out, shocking Deron Williams Metro Elite, 70-62, in the first round of the NBA Red Division championship bracket at Bryan High School. The Rim Rockers ousted a team considered a favorite to advance to the Red Division finals.

How did the Rim Rockers win? The team made great passes. They rebounded well. They took advantage of backdoor cuts. They played solid help-side defense. They dove for loose balls.

"We just execute our plays our coach sends to us," said DeAndre Davis, who scored a game-high 19 points for the Rim Rockers. "We do what we have to do to get the win."

The Rim Rockers were up 10 with four minutes remaining in the first half and went into the locker room with a 33-27 halftime edge. The second half belonged to the Rim Rockers, as they used their fundamental style on both sides of the ball to take a 56-42 lead with 7:39 left to play.

Deron Williams rallied with six minutes remaining, using their frontcourt combination of Jeremy Combs and Carven Holcombe to trim the lead to six. The Rim Rockers silenced the run with buckets by Davis and Chris Runnels. A layup and the foul by C.J. Purvis with 2 ½ minutes left iced the game and gave the Rim Rockers a commanding 67-52 lead.

"We'd heard about them," Davis said of Deron Williams, "but we don't go by what we hear. We go by what we see on the court. [The win] gives us a little confidence. We feel we're a good team, and we feel like we can win the tournament.

Runnels had 18 points, and Deion Robinson had 14 to go along with Davis' 19. Wesley Moore added 10 points for the Rim Rockers. Combs had 16 points, and Erick Neal added 11 for Deron Williams.

The Rim Rockers will have another chance to earn a victory over the Deron Williams program. The Rim Rockers will face Deron Williams Elite 2013 at 9 a.m. Sunday.
