Spring meeting – May 6th (6:30 p.m. start time).


Intend to have incoming 9th graders involved in a 'tour' of the weightroom and other areas of interest to the football players. Hawk will be leading the locker room tour.

History Lesson: Football began 130 years ago. It evolved from soccer and rugby, two sports that were popular in other parts of the world. On November 6, 1869 (just after the Civil War) Princeton and Rutgers (two universities in New Jersey) played the first official American football game. Rutgers won the game 6 – 4. As the game gained in popularity, the need for well defined rules became an important endeavor. Walter Camp, known as the Father of American Football, helped write the first rules for football. Camp also proposed the concept of tackling in 1888, making the sport more violent. After 18 deaths and many serious injuries, football was almost banned in 1906. The game was saved by President Theodore Roosevelt! He convinced college representatives to develop and implement stricter rules to make the game less brutal and dangerous. Boxing, on the other hand, began, by some estimates, around 3,000 BC. Yes, it's an Olympic sport, but do you see boxing fans wearing the coveted Viking's helmet? Or painting their bodies green and yellow? Have you ever seen a boxer climb the stadium wall just to high five an adoring fan? Or has a boxer ever endured an injury as catastrophic as Joe Theismann's? Seriously.
