Meeting Minutes – June 20, 2017

President Dan Landis opened the meeting at 7:00pm.

Team Update presented by Coach Webb

- Over 90 players / day have been present for summer workouts
- 10th grade parents: 10th grade is most difficult year of football because they are now playing against much older boys and no longer just their peers, so they may feel frustrated; keep encouraging them.
- Important Dates:
 - June 26-27 part of team will go to Parkview for camp; rest of team will be off
 - June 29: FCA 7 on 7 at Athens Christian; practice will be held for remaining players
 - Riverside camp will have 5 other teams there; staying on campus; Coach Webb will advise if parents can watch camp.

Financial Update Presented by Steve Canup

Steve Canup reviewed the YTD Financial Management Report as of June 20, 2017. Copies of the report and bank statements were present and available for review by any member wishing to do so.

- Income highlights:
 - \$15,057 in cow raffle ticket sales; still need to purchase cow and freezer; approximately 55 players have paid the majority of their fees via the Cow Raffle
 - \$3,000 in game sponsorships, which are used to feed players before the game
 - \$5,957.05 in TD Club Memberships despite the limited number of TD Club Memberships sold thus far. Parents are encouraged to join the TD club. Depending on the level of membership at which you join, a portion or all of the membership fee will apply to your player fees
 - \$2,406 in Future Bulldogg Camp registrations; registration is still open
 - \$7,270.88 from Greeson Open registrations, raffles, sponsorships and donations
 - \$4,206 Spring Game + an additional \$1,664.10 from concession stands and \$1,957.00 in spirit wear sales. Thanks to everyone who volunteered to make the event a huge success!
- Expense highlights:
 - \$1,250 in Coaching Bonuses
 - \$1,100 paid out in Gridiron for GGals scholarships
 - \$1,000 in camp expenses
- Player Fee invoices coming soon now that cow raffle is over
