
Game Day Shirts

- \$15 each (Small X-Large). Larger sizes available for an additional fee. Refer to order form for pricing details.
- We ask that each girl purchase a game day shirt for wearing on game day.
- This is a short-sleeve, white shirt, in a dri-fit type fabric and includes the district game schedule on the back.
- O Parents and family members are also welcome to order.



Spirit/Fan Shirts -

Concessions

- <u>Initial Donation</u>: Every family is expected to donate items or funds to help us start the season. Initial donations must be brought on Wolverine Night.
 - O Suggested donations to bring on Wolverine Night:
 - 9A and 9B 2 12-packs (12 oz) of Sprite, Coke, Coke Zero, Dr. Pepper, Root Beer
 - JV 2 cases of bottled water (16 oz)
 - Varsity 2 8-packs of Gatorade (20 oz)
 - o In lieu of bringing a donation on Wolverine Night, you may contribute \$20.
- <u>Additional Donations:</u> We welcome, and are grateful for, contributions families would like to make to the concession stand throughout the year. Feel free to bring items to the concession stand. Individual packages of chips, candy, fruit, and beverages are popular.

Volunteering in the Concession Stand

- Every family is required to volunteer in the concession stand two times (minimum) throughout the season.
- O Each time you volunteer, you receive one free food and one free drink item during your shift
- Each time you volunteer, you will receive free entry into the game for the day
- Please volunteer for a time when your daughter is NOT playing.

- In lieu of volunteering to work two concession shifts during the season, families may choose to donate an additional \$100 as a buyout.

• Pre-paid Concession Cards

- O We are offering a convenient option to purchase a \$25 pre-paid concession credit
- O These may be used at home games during the 2025 season.
- O You may purchase the \$25 concessions card tonight or throughout the season.
- O The card will be held at the concession stand, so that your player may visit the concession stand without cash or other payment methods.
- O Note: Unused funds at the end of the season will be donated to the volleyball program.

The Booster Club manages the Clear Brook Volleyball website, which includes:

Communications

The Booster Club sends frequent communications and reminders about upcoming games and other activities. To receive communications, be sure to download the SportsYou app and join the "CB Volleyball Booster Club (2025 season)" group. The team code for joining is 6PCY-ZV2Q.

Team Parents/Liaisons

Each team needs to designate a team parent, who will be responsible for a short but important list:

- <u>Creating Team GroupMe</u> (or some other group contact app) so that all parents can easily
 communicate with each other. This is a great way to share the scores with all parents so that those
 not present get to feel like they are present. Sometimes we also need to quickly share info about an
 away game running late or send brief reminders about deadlines.
- <u>Communicating with the Booster Club officers</u> We'll share information with you to then share in the team's GroupMe (for example, a late bus).
- Organizing one team lunch order The Booster Club buys lunch for each team one time each season; we'll ask for your help with getting girls' orders and making sure it's delivered.
- <u>Coordinating the Homecoming Float</u> Collaborate to access truck and trailer, encourage girls with planning, theme and décor
- Taking pictures for the end-of-year slide show

Website Photos

The Booster Club pays for website pictures each year, including individual shots of each girl and team. You will have access to the digital pictures. ALL girls are required to attend - there is NO make-up session.

Locker Decoration

Big Sister / Little Sister Gift Exchanges

We have three big sis / lil sis gift exchanges during the year to help welcome the freshmen players to the Clear Brook Volleyball program. To get started, the upperclassmen select a freshman player to adopt as their little sister. They will introduce themselves and share a little bit about themselves (likes and favorites). They will collect similar information from their lil sis. Each gift exchange should not be more than \$5 - \$10 each. Dates for this year are:

Booster Club Purchased Lunches for Tournaments

Each year the Booster Club purchases a meal for each team during one of their tournaments. We'll provide players with a choice of options and ask the team parent to help coordinate ordering and delivery. This year, the Booster Club will be buying lunches for the girls on the following dates:

- Freshman A & B CCISD tournament on September 20
- Junior Varsity Goose Creek CSD tournament on August 30
- Varsity Dickinson tournament on August 16

Homecoming

Traditionally, there is a Homecoming Parade the Wednesday before homecoming. Historically, each team has designed and created their own parade float that carries players and coaches for each team. Each team is responsible for securing a trailer, truck and driver for their float. Girls throw candy and/or small trinkets to the spectators along the parade route (usually from the nearby volunteer fire station to the Clear Brook front parking lot). This year, homecoming is after volleyball season. Discussion will be required with the players and coaches to determine if and how they would like to participate in the parade. Score Table Recognition

The electronic score table located in the JV/Varsity gym is available to purchase for space to recognize your Lady Wolverine. We will roll out a coordinated effort to highlight Senior players for Senior Night in October. You are also welcome to reach out to the Booster Club to highlight your player on the score table for \$25 for any home game. Ideas may include birthdays or special accomplishment highlights. Reach out to any Booster Club officer for additional information.

End-of-Year Banquet

Each year, the program celebrates with an end-of-year banquet, usually held at an area country club or other event venue. Girls dress up, we all eat dinner, coaches give awards, we watch slideshows or videos for each team, and then girls take a ridiculous number of pictures. We have a committee working on the banquet – we would love additional help...please let us know if you are interested.

- Date and time TBD (usually in early December)
- What teams can be doing now: Taking lots of pictures and videos of your girls in action so you'll have lots of material to work with for the slideshow

Scholarships

Each year, the Booster Club awards scholarships to eligible seniors. Girls must submit a scholarship application, including a personal statement. To be eligible to apply, girls must have played volleyball for all four years of high school. Additionally, parents must have been a member of the Booster Club in good standing for each year their daughter played, and parents must have fulfilled service commitments to the Booster Club (12 hours of service over the 4-year period.)

Volunteering
