The FIFTH annual **Indian Trail boys volleyball camp** will take place July 24-27, 2017, at the high school located at 6800 60th St. in Kenosha. Cost of the camp is \$60 for high schoolers and includes a T-shirt for all pre-registered campers. The cost of the camp remains the same for all athletes, regardless if they can make only two or three out of the four days.

The camp is all-inclusive. Students from any high school or middle school may attend. The high school camps begins at 4 p.m. and end at or shortly after 7 p.m. each day.

This year, the camp is being led by Indian Trail boys volleyball coach Brian Sharkey. Staff members of Indian Trail, other high school coaches, club coaches and collegiate athletes from throughout the area will work with athletes throughout the week for this all-skills camp. The camp continues to grow each year, so we encourage all parents/athletes to get signed up early in case a waiting list will have to be formed.

All abilities, from beginner to experienced senior in high school are welcome to participate.
