QUALIFICATIONS

A wrestler must be a current registered AAU member and attend school in the State of Missouri to be eligible to compete in the Missouri AAU State Wrestling Championships.

DIVISIONS

Gold Division: For wrestlers with less than one (1) year experience.

Blue Division: Open to any competitor meeting age requirement but is intended for wrestlers with more than one (1) year experience.

AGES & WEIGHTS

Age Groups:

Tot - Born in 2010 or later

Bantam - Born in 2008 or 2009

Midget - Born in 2006 or 2007

Novice - Born in 2004 or 2005

Schoolboy - Born July 1, 2002 - December 31, 2003

Cadet - Born January 1, 2000 - June 30, 2002 (8th Grade or Under)

Gold Division: Gold division wrestlers are NOT required to weigh-in. Gold division wrestlers should be weighed by their coaches at their club practice. Please select an accurate weight class for all Gold wrestlers at the time of registration. If challenged, Gold division wrestlers must be no more than 3% greater than the weight class listed on their official registration or they will be disqualified and forfeit any matches they have wrestled. Challenging a Gold wrestler's weight requires a \$20 deposit. Deposit will be returned if wrestler is disqualified from the tournament. Please provide exact weight for HWT entries.

ADMISSION

Admission is free for all spectators.

Blue Division: Plaque for "Most Falls by Champion" in each age group. Tiebreaker will be determined by the shortest combined time. Plaques for top 3 team finishes. See below for team scoring.....

TEAM SCORING

Blue Division team scores are based on the top 6 places in each bracket.

6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd....., 1 point for 6th

RULES

Double elimination, MSHSAA (Folk Style) match rules will apply. Length of bouts for Tot, Bantam, Midget, Novice (1-1-1). Schoolboy, Cadet, and High School (2-1-1). Only AAU certified wrestling coaches allowed on mats. **Spectators must remain in the stands.**
