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We had beautiful weather at Band Camp and an amazing performance, Friday night!!! Mrs. Stephens and I haven't stopped raving about what a hard working group of rookies we have this year. This was a great week of camp for us. The hard work though is just beginning. Parents, we need your help. It is vital that everyone is at practices. Wednesdays and Thursdays are mandatory for performance at weekend events. Eligibility starts week 3 of school; stay on top of grades. Encourage healthy eating, drinking water, stretching, and sleeping! All of these things help keep her safe and healthy for the season ahead.

I also wanted to remind you that splits and head high kicks are a Warriorette standard! You will be cut from the show if you cannot perform the routine, kicks, or splits to the standard we have set. It is unfair to the rest of the team for the performance to suffer. With that said, encourage stretching daily at home. Ask to see your daughter's splits and kicks. Help her stretch. Challenges are held the Wednesday of each week. If you are cut from any part of the show, attendance is still required at all events and practices.

As we approach the first game, I think it is important you are prepared for the season. Here are a few hints to help keep you and your daughter organized.

- Put your daughter's initials inside of EVERYTHING!
- Only hand-wash (not even gentle cycle) the uniform in cold water and Woolite.
- Buy plenty of sheer-to-waist hose to always have an extra to send in her bag to performances. Stock up now! (No Nonsense is a cheap and popular brand)
- Learn how to french braid, if possible.
- Provide bobby pins, hair ties (clear), and hair spray for her Warriorette bag.
- Remember that any bags, blankets, and jackets brought to games must be school colors.
- Make every effort to show up on time to pick up your child at the end of an event. It is extremely disrespectful of our time to keep advisors and directors waiting, especially when many of our late Friday nights are followed by early Saturday mornings. Thank you in advance for your consideration and attention to this matter.

Fall sports are fast approaching and we are gearing up for an exciting season of soccer and football concessions! Thank you to everyone that has already signed up through Signup Genius to help at our home football games! I also just received the soccer schedule, and greatly appreciate everyone that already signed up to help at the season openers on August 16. There are more games the following

week, so look for many more opportunities to help with soccer concessions through Signup Genius. Remember, soccer games provide an opportunity for our students to get involved with concessions, too!

I also expect that Wayne will again host JV football games on the Saturday mornings following away varsity football games. These will also be added to Signup Genius as soon as that is confirmed. Concessions is a TREMENDOUS source of fundraising, however, that also means it takes a considerable amount of time and effort. For a home football game alone, there are 46 shifts to cover, and it will take a little sacrifice by everyone to cover ALL our soccer and football games. Please consider volunteering more than the minimum requirement to keep our profits in-house and going to our marchers and warriorettes. When we are unable to provide enough of our own volunteers, then we are forced to get volunteers from other organizations, who then receive a portion of our profits. Last year we paid over \$2700 of our Fall profits to other organizations - imagine what we could have done to benefit your band member or warriorette with that extra money!

I also want to share that I was recently told by our Coke Representative that we have the Gold Standard for high school concessions! He said he even recently suggested that a local university come check out our operation and take some notes, because they could learn some things from us! We should all be very proud of what we are accomplishing with Concessions! I am looking forward to seeing you all out at the

Volunteer to work bingo on Saturdays and/or Sundays and you can earn a **\$40.00 (increased from \$35)** educational credit for each day that you work. The Center is **SMOKE FREE !!!**

What types of expenses will this credit cover? The credit can be used for:

- Participation Fees for High School and Middle School Band, Chorus, and Clubs

In fairness to the many people wanting to volunteer, you may select 2 dates per month during the 1st 2 weeks that the book is available. After that you may choose as many unclaimed spots as exist.
