Games: Each team will play four 60-minute games, weather permitting, with a goal of no more than two games played per day. The Gold Championship will be an 80 minute match.

Each team will need to supply a ball boy/girl for each game they play.

Tournament Format:

<u>Pool Play</u>: The 8 participating teams have been divided into two pools of four teams each. Pool assignments have been seeded based on information gathered from participating teams for the 2017 spring season.

Friday's Pool Play will determine seeding for Saturday's championship flights. There will be Gold and Silver brackets. The 1st and 2nd teams of each pool will go to gold bracket and the 3rd and 4th place teams

will go to the silver bracket.

Pool Play Point System: This point system will be used in Friday's Pool Play to seed Saturday's Championship flights. Pool winners will be determined based on points accumulated during pool play.

- 1. 3 points awarded for each win
- 2. 1 point awarded for each tie [A total of 3 points per match and 6 points total is possible.]

Tie Breaker: Head to Head result within Pool. If the teams in question are still tied, then points from 3 and 4 below will be added to those accumulated in 1 and 2 above to determine a winner [placement].

- 3. 1 point awarded for each shutout (including 0-0)
- 4. 1 point awarded for each goal scored (up to 3 goals per match) [A total of 7 points per match and 14 points total is possible.]

If a tie still exists, then the following criteria will be used (in the order listed) to determine a winner [placement]:

- 5. Cumulative goal differential (maximum 3 goals per game)
- 6. Fewest goals allowed
- 7. Most goals scored
- Modified NFHS Tie Game Procedure (penalty kick procedure only) [Scheduled at the end of Pool Play if possible. Otherwise, 45 minutes prior to start time of affected Championship Flight game.]

- 1. Saturday—Letters and numbers in Team column refer to Friday Pools A and B]. The number following the letter indicates finish in pool based on Friday's play. Finally, the results based on Game Numbers are used to indicate who is playing in a particular match.
- 2. No games will go to overtime. When necessary, Saturday games will be decided in a penalty-kick shootout. The penalty-kick shootout will follow standard procedure with each team having 5 shooters. If the number of made Penalty-Kicks is tied after the first 5 Penalty-Kicks, then each succeeding round will consist of a single Penalty-Kick per team.
- 3. All matches will be 30-minute halves with a 5-minute half time except for the Gold Flight Championship match, which will be 40-minute halves with a 10-minute half time. There will be no overtime play. Matches tied at the end of regulation in the Championship Flights on Saturday will go straight to a Penalty Kick Shoot-Out.
