General Information

Campers will not be allowed to leave campus without PERMISSION or SUPERVISION by a staff member.

All swimming will be supervised with certified lifeguards on duty.

Coaches and Counselors will stay with residential campers at night in the Concord University Dorms.

Location

The camp is held on the campus of Concord University in Athens, West Virginia, 6 miles north of Princeton, just off Rt. 20 and 15 miles from I-77 and Rt. 460.



Food & Lodging

The campers will be in a dormitory with 2 persons per room. Preference for roommates may be indicated at registration.

The campers will be provided meals at subway sides or the meals will be catered in.

Camp Facilities

The softball camp will be held at the CU Softball field located adjacent to the football stadium.

In the event of inclement weather, the camp will be held in the CU Carter Center. Two gymnasiums are located on the main level, as well as a swimming pool.

A camper planning to stay overnight should bring casual summer clothes, swim wear, complete practice outfits, socks, tennis shoes, glove, cleats if camper has them, helmet and bat if available, towels, toiletries, pillow, linens for a twin bed, a blanket, a fan, and spending money. Also, catchers will need to bring their own catching gear.

Arrival/Departure

Campers should plan to arrive on the first day of camp at 1:00 pm. Registration will take place in the lobby of the Carter Center between 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm. The first session will begin at 2:30 pm. Camp will conclude at 3:00 pm on June 13.



Camp Objectives

- **For beginners:** Instruct the fundamental aspects associated with the game of fast-pitch softball.
- Learn the basic and proper techniques to help establish a solid foundation for both the offensive and defensive game.
- This camp will also include pitching and catching skill development.
- **Advanced Skill Development:** Take your game to the next level by learning the dimensions of softball beyond the basics. This section is for skilled athletes who are proficient at the basic fundamental skills of softball. During this time, athletes will be challenged both offensively and defensively through a series of skill specific drills. Advanced pitching and catching will be included in this session.
- Team competition will consist of 9 players per team
- We will expect good sportsmanship at all times
- We think the game of softball is fun and plan to play it that way.
