Winner's Bracket



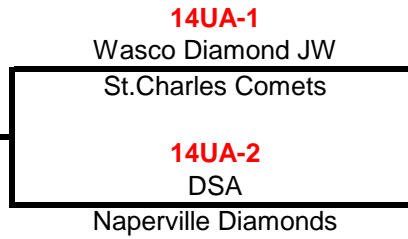

10th Annual Wasco Diamonds Fastpitch Classic May 23rd-25th, 2014 Tournament Rules

General Tournament Rules:

- 2014 PGF/High School rules shall apply except as modified and noted below.
- 12u/14u PGF Qualifier Tournament Format: 4GG - 2 Pool Play games into Double Elimination Bracket - weather permitting.
- All teams must check in prior to 1st game at Anderson Park Tournament Headquarters. A copy of a copy of your roster and a copy of your insurance certificate must be turned over at check-in. Managers must keep a copy of birth certificates at all times. **Any team found violating eligibility rules will be disqualified and entry fee forfeited.**
- Umpire decision is final.
- Teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time except 1st game of the day. Due to the distance some teams are traveling, the tournament committee reserves the right to determine when a game shall be forfeited.
- During pool play, all rostered players present are eligible to bat in lineup. Free defensive substitution. Courtesy runner, if used, will be last batted out. During bracket play all rules revert to 2014 PGF/High School rules.
- Mercy/Run Ahead Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings (2 ½ if home team is ahead), 10 runs after 4 innings (3 ½ if home team is ahead), 8 runs after 5 innings (4 ½ if home team is ahead).
- **Time limits:** Pool Play are 1:15 Drop Dead, Score is score – no revert back. Bracket Games: 1:45 Finish the Inning, If tied at this time International Tie Breaker will be used No new innings will start after 1:45.
- Pool play games ending in tie, winners will be determined by coin flip.
- Game clock will stop for injuries requiring additional time for ambulatory care. Game clock will stop for injuries, which require cleansing and bandaging at umpires discretion.
- During pool play, all extra innings after 7 full innings have been completed **and time remains** will be played using the International Tie Breaker.
- If, on the judgment of the umpire, a team is determined to be stalling, time will be added to the game clock **and** the violating **manager and coaches** will be restricted to the bench for the remainder of the game.

2014 Wasco Diamonds Classic Tournament Rules (cont.)

- New pitchers will be permitted 5 warm-up pitches. Returning pitchers will be permitted 3 warm-up pitches. No infield or outfield balls will be permitted after the 1st inning. Teams will not be permitted to warm-up on the infield prior to the game. Teams may warm up in the outfield prior to the game if the field is open and time permits.
- Uniforms must be worn AS DESIGNED. Tucked in all the way around and sleeves down. **Bandanas or handkerchiefs will not be permitted at any time on the field (this includes under catchers or batting helmets).** Violation of uniform rule will result in the restriction of the player for the game. Continued violations will result in the restriction of the manager.
- Jewelry will not be worn by players.
- Team Listed on Top or 1st in pool play will occupy the 3rd base dug-out
- Higher seed in bracket play will occupy the 3rd base dug-out (unless a team from the previous game remains on the field).
- During pool play, home team will be determined by double coin flip. Winner of coin flip gets choice of home or away. Coin Flip and Umpire Conferences will take place 5 minutes Prior to the Game time on the Master Schedule
- During championship play, the higher seeded team gets choice of home or away. If seeded the same, a coin flip will be used. Coin Flip and Umpire Conferences will take place 5 minutes prior to the Game Time on the Mater Schedule
- (1) Game played makes the tournament official and there will be no refunds do to inclement weather except as noted on registration form.
- In the event of inclement weather, the Tournament Director or Assisting Tournament Director has the authority to revise the tournament format in order to complete the tournament.
- In the event of inclement weather, and play is suspended, it will be the responsibility of the team manager to stay in contact with the Tournament Director and/or Assistant Tournament Director. It will be the responsibility of the team manager to consult with the Tournament Director regarding seeding for Championship Play. Seeding will be calculated at the end of the last pool play game in each age bracket.
- **Absolutely no negative chattering is permitted by opposing players, coaches or parents. Positive cheering/chattering for your own team is permitted and encouraged. Umpires will be instructed to issue a bench warning to any team in the unlikely event that such negative chattering persists by a team, and if it continues to persist after the warning, to disqualify the player or remove the coach or parent.**
- **Absolutely no noisemakers, horns, clappers, claxons or anything else deemed to be distracting by the Tournament director shall be used. A warning will be issued; subsequent violations of the rule will result in removal from premises of the offending fans and/or disqualification of the team. Managers are responsible for informing their fans of this requirement.**
- **Absolutely no alcoholic beverages are allowed at the park, including the parking lot. Violation will result in forfeiture of the game for offending team if parents/fans break this rule.**

2014 Wasco Diamonds Classic Tournament Rules (cont.)

- **SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN THE PARKING LOT ONLY. This will be enforced by all tournament staff members. Managers please tell your team parents that this will not be tolerated !**
- **NO FIREARMS ALLOWED ON PARK PROPERTY**

Concessions and tournament t-shirts will be available all weekend.

This tournament and sport is about the female athletes that enjoy competing and playing the game. So let's remember to set a good example for them by being positive and supportive fans and exemplify good sportsmanship in all aspects of their tournament.
