The Acalanes Dons baseball program has won the last three North Coast Section Division 3 Championships. The Dons play in the tough Diablo Foothill Athletic League (DFAL). Since Coach Hughes has taken over the program in 2010, the Dons have posted a 73-32-1 record with nine of his former players continuing on to college baseball.

PRESEASON OUTLOOK

PITCHING: The strength of the Acalanes Dons has been pitching. Last season, the pitching staff had an ERA of under one and was led by 2013 DFAL Most Valuable Pitcher and All-State selection Johnny York and First-Team All-League Andrew Merken. Both pitchers have graduated but juniors Zach Stromberg and Casey Harrington along with seniors Doug Nimura and Alec Weber look to continue the Dons dominance on the mound.

OFFENSE: The Dons return most of their top hitters from a year with seniors Austin Fisher, Grant Henderson and Max Diaz, Junior Tommy Nimura and Sophomores Jake Berry and Tommy Henderson looking to lead the way offensively for the Dons.

DEFENSE: Pitching and defense win Championships and that is the formula used by the Dons in its past three NCS runs. The formula for success in 2014 should prove no different. The Dons return four defensive starters from last year's squad with CF Tommy Nimura anchoring the outfield with Austin Fisher and Jake Berry forming a strong middle infield.

Today's game features two NCS Champs from a year ago as the Amador Valley Dons (Div. 1) take on the Acalanes Dons (Div. 3) in a non-league contest. Amador Valley posted a record of 18-10 last season and 7-7 in league play (East Bay Athletic League) while scoring 115 runs and giving up 98. Seeded fourth in the NCS Div. 1 playoffs, they proceeded to get on a roll and won the NCS Finals against De La Salle, 3-1. This is their first game of the 2014 campaign.
