DONS GAME RECAPS

Acalanes Dons 4 · Dublin Gaels 3 (10 Innings)

Acalanes Dons took home a hard fought 4-3 victory over Dublin Gaels on Thursday at Dublin HS.

With the score tied at 3 in the 10th, SS Austin Fisher, who made a few web gems earlier in the game, walked after two were out. Fisher then stole second base setting up Josh Katzki's clutch double down the left field line, scoring Fisher.

Fisher got on base three times in the game for the Dons with singles in the 1st and 5th innings while adding an RBI. But Fisher wasn't done. He also got the win in relief for Acalanes pitching 1 1/3 innings, striking out three and allowing no runs. Doug Nimura pitched brilliantly in relief, holding the Gaels scoreless in his 4 2/3 inning of work to set up the 10th inning heroics.

The Gaels jumped out to an early 2-0 lead in the bottom of the 1st and led 3-1 into the 5th. The Dons tied it at 3 in the 5th on a single by Matt Jorgensen, Ryan Ericksen HBP, an RBI single by Max Diaz and Fisher. That's where it stayed until Katzki's game winner.

The Campolindo Cougars, coached by Max Luckhurst, are four time reigning NCS Division II Champions. The Cougars are led by pitcher Matt Ladrech and third baseman Denis Karas both of whom will be playing for the Golden Bears next season in Berkeley. Campolindo enters the game with a 5 game winning streak, 3-0 DFAL record and 6-2 overall. Campo has dominated DFAL in recent years having won the league title the past four seasons while compiling a 38-10 league record and 85-25-3 overall. Face-to-face meetings in these 4 years have the teams splitting their season series in 2010, 2012 and 2013 with Campo winning both games in 2011.

The crafty left handed pitcher is a real student of the game where he has learned to get batters out without the benefit of overpowering them. Doug Nimura is a smart pitcher that knows the game very well. His leadership is invaluable as he loves to pass on his knowledge to his teammates and others to make them better. In fact, Doug, along with his brother and teammate Tommy, help their dad coach a 12 year old team from Moraga. His goals for the season are lofty. Besides wanting to be the best teammate possible, Nimura looks to post an ERA under 1.50 with less than 20 walks and at least 20 appearances on the season. Given that he has given up just 2 earned runs in 20.1 innings and has pitched in 7 of the Dons 9 ball games, he is well on his way of achieving his goals. As for the team, his goals are to go undefeated in league, have a staff ERA of under 3.00 and, of course, win a fourth straight NCS Championship. Doug's favorite memory so far at Acalanes was watching Johnny York's perfect game in the semi-finals of last year's NCS Playoffs. Nimura says he "lives for pressure". Well, being the go to relief pitcher for the Dons should help quench that desire.

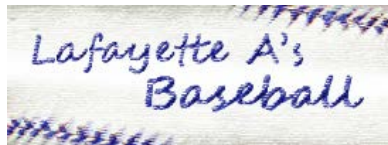
