

Reminder: Everyone signed a document stating that they agree to follow the COVID-19 Rules as a condition of playing BRLL baseball this season. All tests, symptoms, close contact, etc. must be reported by email to covid@bocalittleleague.com Failure to do so risks your team forfeiting any game played when a player or coach had knowledge of COVID-19 symptoms or a COVID-19 positive test. No coach or manager can clear a player to return only the COVID email address can do so.

А	Symptoms of COVID-19	 Person must: (a) report the symptoms to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The team manager must also immediately report it to covid@bocalittleleague.com. Obtain either a laboratory antigen or PCR test. a. If the laboratory antigen or PCR test is positive, follow the required steps for a positive test. b. If the laboratory antigen or PCR test is negative, the player can return. Do not attend any BRLL activities unless and until cleared by covid@bocalittleleague.com
В	Test Positive for COVID-19	 Person must: (a) report the positive test to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The team manager must also immediately report it to covid@bocalittleleague.com. Person must remain away from all BRLL activities until both of the following conditions are satisfied: (1) five days from either (i) the date the laboratory administered first positive test is administered or (ii) five days from the date the first at home positive test is reported to covid@bocalittleleague.com; and (2) no fever or other symptoms of COVID-19 within the prior 24-hours.
С	Vaccinated person is a Close Contact to a COVID-19 positive person	 Person must: (a) report the close contact to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The team manager must also immediately report it to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The vaccinated person does not need to stay away from BRLL activities unless the person develops symptoms of COVID-19. If the person develops symptoms of COVID-19, the person must follow the steps above in Row A. Do not attend any BRLL activities unless and until cleared by covid@bocalittleleague.com



D Cl p h d	Contact with a person is a Close contact with a person that tested positive for COVID-19. Note: This does not apply if the close contact with the COVID-19 positive person was more than 48-nours before the person first developed symptoms or tested positive for COVID-19	 Person must: (a) report the close contact to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The team manager must also immediately report it to covid@bocalittleleague.com. Person must remain away from all BRLL activities for 5-days after the last close contact with the COVID-19 positive person. On or after the fifth day after the last exposure to the COVID-19 positive person, obtain either a laboratory antigen or PCR test. If the laboratory antigen or PCR test is positive, follow the required steps above in Row B. If the laboratory antigen or PCR test is negative, the player can return. Do not attend any BRLL activities unless and until cleared by covid@bocalittleleague.com
E SY th	Unvaccinated Person has Close Contact with a person that has symptoms of COVID-19 either: (a) at he time of the close contact; or (b) within 48 hours after the close contact.	 Person must: (a) report the close contact to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. Person must remain away from all BRLL activities for 5-days after the last close contact with the COVID-19 positive person. On or after the fifth day after the last exposure to the COVID-19 positive person, obtain either a laboratory antigen or PCR test. If the laboratory antigen or PCR test is positive, follow the required steps above in Row B. If the laboratory antigen or PCR test is negative, the player can return. NOTE: If the person with symptoms of COVID-19 obtains a laboratory antigen or PCR test showing the person does not have COVID-19, the person exposed to the person with symptoms will no longer be required to follow the above-steps. As with all clearance, that clearance will come from the COVID email address. Do not attend any BRLL activities unless and until cleared by covid@bocalittleleague.com

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F	A person in the household of the unvaccinated person tests positive for COVID-19	 Person must: (a) report the close contact to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The person must follow the guidelines for exposure explained above in Row D beginning at the end of the household members quarantine period. (i.e. the five-day quarantine period for the person begins after the end of the household members required quarantine). Do not attend any BRLL activities unless and until cleared by covid@bocalittleleague.com
G	Close Contact with a person that was in contact with a COVID-19 Positive Person (Secondary contact)	No quarantine at this time but additional facts and updates may be requested.
н	Player/Coach Notified As Close Contact By School or Other Organization	 Person must: (a) report the close contact to the team manager and directly to <u>covid@bocalittleleague.com</u>. The team manager must also immediately report it to <u>covid@bocalittleleague.com</u>. Person must follow the appropriate section above, Row C, D, or E.
J	Player/Coach on Team Tests Positive for COVID-19 or Develops Symptoms of COVID-19 Within 48-hours of Team Event	 Person must: (a) report the close contact to the team manager and directly to covid@bocalittleleague.com. The team manager must also immediately report it to covid@bocalittleleague.com. Team Players, Coaches, Managers, On-Field Volunteers a. Any vaccinated person without symptoms will be required to proceed in accordance with Row C. b. Any unvaccinated person will be required to proceed in accordance with Row D or E (as appropriate). Team Events During Period of Quarantine a. If the less than 50% of the rostered players are able to participate, all team events will be canceled for the following five-days. b. If more than 50% of the rostered players are able to participate, the league will attempt to provide substitute players. c. Under no circumstance will a team be determined to have forfeited if covid@bocalittleleague.com determines a game must be canceled.
