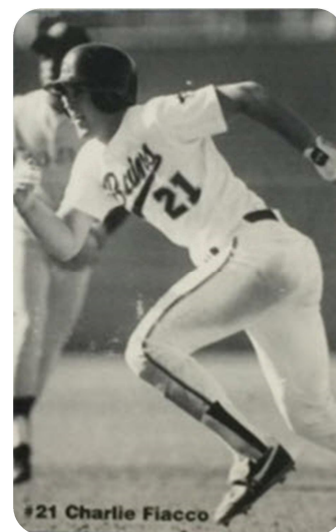


Spotlight on our Scorpion Alumni
