TUTORIALS TO BEGIN THIS WEEK

As a program, we always make sure that we place academics at the forefront of what we do. With that in mind, we are going to begin assigning tutorials to our players who are falling behind on their grades. We waited to begin our tutorials this week to allow teachers time to input grades and also due to the short, hectic week last week.

This is what our academic plan looks like: Any player who has below a 75 in a class at the beginning of a week will be assigned to attend two tutorial sessions with their teachers that week. We set the mark at 75 to ensure we limit the chance of any surprises at the end of the 6-week grading period. This means two tutorial sessions in total, not two per class.
