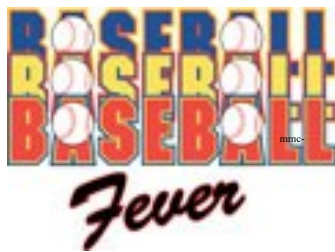

VARSITY SPLITS OPENING SERIES AGAINST HAYS

The Varsity squad fought hard in both games of the Hays series this week, earning a split with a quality district opponent.

On Tuesday night, the Timberwolves were led by Kyle McClure on the mound. McClure struck out 3, scattered 3 hits, and allowed 4 walks across 5 complete innings, all while keeping the Hawks off the scoreboard. McClure turned the ball over to Damian Alonzo, who pitched 2 complete innings, allowing just 1 hit and no walks to preserve the shutout victory.

At the plate, the Hays pitching staff was able to keep us out of the hit column, but not from scoring a run. In the top of the first, Kyle McClure hit a firm ground ball that

the second baseman was unable to handle, allowing Bryce Schneider to score from second.

On Friday night, the Varsity squad fell late to Hays in a 12-3 loss. On the mound for the Timberwolves, Griffin Giltrap got the start, going 5.1 innings, striking out 6 while allowing just 4 hits, 4 runs (3 earned), and walking just two. The Timberwolves were led on the offensive end by Bryce Schneider and Kyle McClure, with 1 RBI apiece.

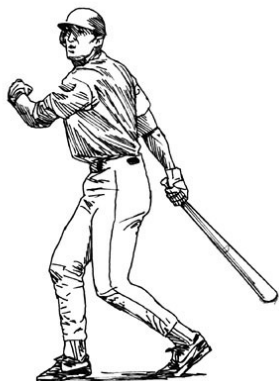
