The game ended up requiring an effort from just about the entire pitching staff, with appearances by Kyle McClure, Damian Alonzo, Connor Norris, and Aiden Herrera. At the plate, Bryce Schneider led the way with 2 hits, and Hudson Cuevas contributed 2 RBIs.

On Wednesday, the Varsity team came out and attacked the new day like a team trying to be 1-0 by the end of the day, walking away with an

impressive 6-1 win. On the mound, Griffinn Giltrap pitched well, scattering 5 hits and 4 walks over 5 innings, while only allowing 1 run and striking out 6. Bryce Schneider came in and closed the door for the final 2 innings, allowing 2 hits and striking out 4. At the plate, Cooper Camacho was swinging a hot bat with 3 hits and 4 RBIs. 
