

CRHS Baseball Booster Meeting  
March 19, 2026

Meeting called to order at 6:33 PM

### **Beer Bust: Ryan**

- We have \$2000.00 in sponsorships and about 40 raffle prizes. The goal is to have \$3500.00 in sponsorships and 50 prizes
- Expenses will include \$125.00 per keg and a small amount for some decorations on the prize table. Mike motioned to approve a \$50.00 budget for decorations for the beer bust. It was seconded by Rachel. All agreed.
- Zach has put out flyers at Chasers and a couple other places.
- We will collect the money and either put a red X on the hand or use bracelets.
- The patrons will then go to the bar to get the cup and first pour. The bartender will then check IDs
- We can have volunteers pour beer from pitchers and sell raffle tickets. Gina will set up a Sign-Up Genius for the volunteers.
- We have Square and PayPal. Mike is working on Venmo.
- Denise has a cash box. Ryan has raffle tickets.
- Ryan will make a full list of sponsors and donors by Wednesday. We will have Coach G thank the sponsors on social media. We should also mention that all the proceeds go to the boys.

Mark motioned to approve the minutes and seconded by Mike.

### **Treasurer's Report: Mike**

Checking: \$11,559.35

Savings: \$28,909.60

5 checks went out:

- Rebyl – Coaches jackets and player pack t-shirts
- Minnesota Equipment – Mower
- Lakeshirts Zephyr, LLC – Hats
- Wilkens Athletics – Control panel for pitching machine
- Mike McCauley – PO Box for 1 year

The PO Box must not have been paid because we no longer had one. Any mail that went to the PO Box was returned to the sender. Mike was able to reactivate the same box and paid for one year. Mark stated that he found out because a sign sponsor got the check back. Mark will let the sign sponsors know that the PO Box is now good to mail to again.

### **Vice President: Denise**

- Snap Raise just kicked off. Parents should have gotten an email from Snap.
- Gerten's is going well. We have about \$1900.00 in sales. Gerten's is open until March 30<sup>th</sup>. So, we should get a final push for more orders.

- Cub bagging is coming up. Gina will set up a Sign-Up Genius for volunteers. Denise will get a list of players that have signed up for baseball from Coach.
- We are not going to do the Epilepsy clothing drive. Time got away from us, and we ran out of available dates. We will shoot for doing it next year.
- Gina has volunteered to get the parent gifts for the seniors as long as she has some input from other members.

### **Signage: Mark**

- Mark is waiting on a few checks. At least one was sent back to the sponsor due to the PO Box mishap.
- He will follow up on a few more that he hasn't heard back from.
- He is checking with ABC for a "drop dead" date to be able to have the banners done in time for the first game on April 7<sup>th</sup>.
- We still need to check the current banners to see which ones need to be replaced. If Coach does not have time to do it, Mark and Zach have volunteered to check it out. Mark needs to make sure he still has the correct key for the shed.

### **Zach:**

- Zach is checking on other possible camera options for the fields. The ones that Jessica recommended are about \$300.00 per camera, which would be a one-time cost.
- However, we would still need a data source or a hot spot to stream the games.
- Hot spots have a monthly fee. Rachel said that she will check with Little League on what they pay, but she believes it is about \$15.00 per month.
- It was brought to see if we can just do the 3 months of the baseball season.
- We will ask Coach to see if he can ask around to see what other coaches use for cameras.
- As far as decals, Zach stated that it appears that all of the kids have the CR decal on their helmets, except for 1 boy that didn't play last year.
- We should reach out to Coach Mossey to see if he happens to have any, or to find out where any extras might be, if there are any.

### **Coach Don's Report:**

- Practice Update/Team Status – 33 players have registered at this time. It seems that there will be 3 teams, but can't afford injuries, academic issues or absences. Coach thinks there will be plenty of playing time.
- Snap Raise – Coach and the players met with Valerion on March 19<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM to kick off the fundraiser.
- Apparel with Rebyl – Steve has our spreadsheet of what we need ordered complete with sizing and names.
- Store – The store is closed. There weren't enough for minimum orders on certain things; however, we have a pretty good order being filled.
- Hats – They are in.
- Mower – MN Equipment in Rogers will deliver the mower during Spring Break. The old mower will be moved to the 2<sup>nd</sup> field.
