

Holtville High School Athletic Discipline Contract

As student athletes, you are bound by a more demanding moral and behavioral code than non-student-athletes. As such, you will be responsible for conducting yourself in a manner above and beyond non-student-athletes that represents your family, school, and team in an exemplary manner. If you choose to accept this responsibility, you and your guardian must sign this contract, and in doing so, you agree to abide by the consequences set forth below: Every member of the Holtville High School Athletic Program has a duty to represent himself/herself in the most respectable manner possible. This applies to your behavior both in school and out of school. You are expected to avoid situations where you might be accused of wrong-doing. Being in the "wrong place at the wrong time" is not an excuse, if you chose to be there in the first place. In-school discipline problems resulting in detention, suspension, or alternative school (ECAP) may result in dismissal from the athletic program. The following violations may also result in suspension or dismissal from the Holtville Athletic Program:

1. Use of illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco at any time.
2. Allowing yourself to be in a situation, in school or away from school, where you are accused of/arrested for an illegal activity.
3. Missing practice, games, or training sessions. (unless excused by the Coach).
4. Skipping class or school.
5. Poor sportsmanship; whether determined by game officials or school officials.
6. Harassment (verbal/physical/sexual/etc...) of another student or team member.
7. Any act (either in school or away from school) which in the opinion of the coaching and/or school administration, reflects in a negative manner on the Holtville Athletic Program.
8. Electronic communication (text, Facebook, Twitter, etc...) should be positive and should never negatively reflect on school, other teammates, or coaching staff. If it is not positive don't post it.
9. Failing to abide by the AHSAA academic eligibility parameters; passing all core classes, and maintaining a cumulative average of 70 in all classes.
10. Any show/act of defiance or disrespect to coaches.

By signing below, you affirm that you have read this and fully understand the rules set forth by this contract and you understand that violations of the Holtville High School Athletic Program behavior policies could result in your being dismissed from the athletic program. Additionally, you understand that if you are dismissed from a team for disciplinary reasons or choose not to continue in the activity, no money raised/paid to the program will be refunded and you will not be allowed to participate in another HHS athletic activity until the conclusion of that sport's season.
