1. President's Report

• Senior Banners:

Senior banners were hung on March 24, 2025. Special thanks to Julie Evanish for coordinating this effort.

• Senior Plaques & Team Posters:

Senior plaques and team posters will be displayed in the NASH athletic hallways, once they arrive. Madia Photography will handle hanging them.

• Game Changer Subscription:

A 1-year Game Changer subscription has been purchased and will be used exclusively by the Varsity team. Board and attendees discussed streaming options for JV games. Nicole checked with Coach Sabo and he said we would have to purchase another WiFi pack and add an additional line. Erin is researching the costs associated with this. The Freshman team is being streamed because the Coach pays for it.

• Wi-Fi Subscription:

The Wi-Fi service has been renewed with an auto-renewal set. Sabo will notify the Board when it's time to cancel or suspend the service.

Cumberland Valley Trip:

As of April 2, 2025, the Cumberland Valley trip has been cancelled and will not be rescheduled. Snacks were purchased for this and will be distributed amongst the Freshman, JV and Varsity players when snacks are needed.

Away Game Team Meals:

Volunteers for away game team meals have been secured, except for the Varsity game at NOS. If no volunteers sign up, subs will need to be picked up and delivered to the coaches, along with a cooler, prior to departure for the game.



NOTE: Due to unpredictable weather, the game dates may change, which could impact volunteer availability. If rescheduled, volunteers may need to adjust based on the new dates.

• Water & Gatorade for Away Games:

Water and Gatorade will be purchased for away games where a sandwich or sub is provided.

• Feeding Players at Home Double Headers:

Discussion on whether to continue providing sandwiches or subs at home double headers. It's suggested to only provide these meals for away games, as players can go home or bring their own food for home games. Discussed that discretion will be used when determining team meals. Many factors can influence the decision. (Weather/Time of Arrival/Departure/Coach input). Team parents will decide based on these factors what the meals/snacks will be for each DH and/or away game, keeping within the allocated budget. All receipts for meals, snacks and drinks should be scanned and emailed to the baseball boosters gmail account for reimbursement. Monte Cello's offers a 20% discount to NA and Jersey Mike's in Wexford offers a 10% discount. It is highly encouraged to use these businesses to save money. The NA Baseball Boosters sales tax exemption is already on hand and is not required to be resubmitted to these businesses each time an order is placed.

Alternative options include offering soft pretzels, Rita's for a snack between games, or providing non-perishable snacks. Must also include non-peanut/nut snacks for those with individual allergies. Some other ideas are protein bars and fruit (bananas and apples have seemed to work well in the past).

By-Law Changes:

The bylaws have been updated to state that once a player is selected for the team and their dues and fundraising fees are paid, these fees will not be refunded if the player is injured and unable to participate. This change has been approved by all Board members. Nicole will submit the update to Coach Sabo for posting on the NA Tiger Baseball website. The update will be signed by the current Board members before being posted.

Mission Statement Changes:

The mission statement has been revised to provide more detail, as the original was vague and did not fully reflect the scope of the Boosters' activities and purpose. All Board members have approved the change.
