- Current balance \$47,241 Over \$10,000 raised in sponsorships. Great job by Denise!
- We are in a good place for this time of the year.
- Sponsorship: (Denise)
  - o Total- \$11,155 an increase of \$2,635 from the 22-23 season

## NOTES/COMMENTS:

If a family provides a company sponsorship (new one), their season booster dues would be refunded. Approximately 5 families have participated in this.

- Fundraising: (Group Discussion)
  - Penguins Game- only sold 5 tickets; the minimum was 10 for the fundraising program (2023- \$255)
  - Restaurant nights-
    - Slice on Broadway- raised: \$657.50 very successful! The multiple night option was helpful (Mon. - Thurs.)
  - Team Spirit Store-
    - BSN Online Store:
      - First Store: \$390 (2023- \$660)Second Store: \$360 (2023- \$570)
  - Yard Signs
    - Sold 36, we sold fewer than last year but the cost per sign was less so we ended up raising about the same amount about \$400 made.
    - Still have the 14 unsold plus 50 misprinted signs will bring them to home games and pass out for free. After that the signs will be discarded unless someone else wants to store them for next season.

  - Save your receipts and submit them to the booster email account, along with where you would like the check to be sent.


#### NOTES/COMMENTS:
