Joy would like player information done on google docs in place of the parent forms that have been filled out in the past. Player registration on line may cost 300.00. A suggestion was made to put the money earned from the sale of the Giant Eagle cards toward this fee. Majority of the people at the meeting would prefer to do it all on the website. If a parent doesn't have a PayPal account they can send in a check.

Only turn in a check for apparel at Tigerfest. Wrap the raffle tickets and registration into one payment. One common table will be needed to pick up tickets and drop off apparel check.

A question was asked about what the dues are being put toward. A few of the needs for the dues are listed below.

Money is needed for insurance \$400.00 and small games of chance license 125.00, players t-shirts, gifts at the end of the year, senior night and media guide is another cost. Rental of hall and meals for players and coaches. Senior plaques around 6000.00 for the plaque for the seniors. Boosters are paying for this.

Who makes the decision on the plaques? Who makes that decision to discontinue the plaque?

A comment/ question was stated about the bathroom by the field. Was the construction of the bathroom donated? Construction could start this spring. Boosters will not pay for the bathroom.

Can we sell spirit gear at tiger fest?

We will not make a lot of money at a concession. Is the concession stand worth the hassle?

Admission fee is charged for the games.

No trips planned for this year.

Coach did a quick estimate about the fee to register on line, \$582.00 will be charged based on the 3 percent fee.

The forms can be streamlined for registration Joy and coach will work on that.

It might be nice to have Damon's food truck at a game because they gave us a donation for the website.

Cooperate sponsors any more ideas? We would like to get as many as we could. Our goal is 5000.00 made from sponsors, we have around 2400.00 from cooperate sponsors so far.

The boosters may need to help support the payment of a fence. It will cost around \$10,000. Shaler and Pine Richland make money off of sponsors on banners. It will be nice to have the boosters help out with the fence.
