President's Report

- Player Welcome Packets: Printed by Coach Sabo and distributed by team coaches.

- Apparel Store Update:

- Baseball Character Program:
 - Coach Heck ordered 150 wristbands with this year's theme, "TOGETHER" (leadership & lifestyle lessons for JV/Varsity).
 - o Cost: **\$178.05**, paid by Heck and reimbursed through Booster funds.
 - Wristbands will be distributed with hats at TigerFest.

Athletic Department Updates

- Individual Fundraising Accounts:
 - The district solicitor reaffirmed that Booster groups **cannot** allocate fundraising proceeds to individuals (maintaining 501(c)(3) status).
 - Funds must benefit the entire team or be distributed based on objective criteria.
- Senior Student-Athlete Awards:
 - To ensure compliance, "Scholarship" was replaced with "Award" in all official documentation, including Google form application that will be sent to Senior players after teams are established.

- Application Deadline: April 30, 2025
- Selection Process: The Award Committee & Coaches will select recipients based on established criteria.
 - o **2025 Awards:** \$1,000, \$500, and \$250.

• Next Steps:

- o Coach Sabo to distribute applications once teams are set.
- Promote in March & April newsletters.

UBO Report

- Scholarship Awards
- Follow-up communication from the Athletic Office regarding booster/parent groups sponsoring scholarships for senior student-athletes.
- The District Solicitor's Office has provided guidance on this matter:



- Booster organizations must review their existing purpose clause to determine if scholarships are permitted. If not included, this can be updated in the next 990 filing.
- o IRS rules require an eligibility group and selection criteria (e.g., academic performance, financial need, instructor recommendations, etc.).
- o Funds should be distributed directly to the college of the recipient to ensure proper use.
- Record-keeping requirements must be followed.
- **Recommendation:** Use the term "awards" instead of "scholarships." As noted above, baseball has changed on all related files and documents.
- NOTE: Baseball is in compliance with all awarded monies will be sent directly to awardees college, university or trade school.
- Individual Accounts in Fundraising
- Review of the district's past practice and philosophy:
 - Booster groups are not permitted to have individual accounts when fundraising.
 - Legal opinion from Maiello, Brungo, and Maiello confirms this stance remains unchanged.
 - o IRS regulations must be followed to maintain 501(c)(3) status:
 - No direct fundraising benefit to individual members.
 - Fundraising proceeds should be equally distributed to benefit the entire group or be based on objective criteria.

 - Note: Baseball complies with individual fundraising rules.
