Revised Bylaws: Signed by all board members and effective as of today's date. Posted to natigerbaseball.com for future reference.


Senior Plaques & Team Poster:


- Spring season is underway. Visit the athletic website for schedule updates.

 - Secondary Insurance: Available through North Allegheny Athletics. Forms are in the Athletic Office.
 - Tiger Vision Scoreboards: Boosters will incur video board usage costs starting next year.
 - Unauthorized Video Releases: Booster groups are prohibited from broadcasting interscholastic competitions.

Treasurer's Report

- Current Bank Balance: \$65,320.18
- *Expenses coming up: End of season parties, play off expenses, banquets, team meals.

Coach's Report

- PitchCom for JV: Varsity currently uses PitchCom. Coaches are exploring JV options; Coach Sabo received a quote of \$1,875.
- End-of-season gift for John Conyetti: Board approved request for \$100 gift card in appreciation of his work on the baseball field.
- Coach recognition: Board approved request for \$100 gift card for each of the 6 JV/Varsity coaches; matching jackets already purchased (~\$72 each).
- Postseason gummy bears tradition: Board approved request for a package of gummy bears for each player (not coaches) before each postseason game.
- Rita's team treat: Coaches take the team to Rita's following a practice leading up to a playoff game.
- Postseason meal tradition: If Varsity wins a postseason game, coaches take players to Cenci's for a team meal.

- PIAA travel support: If a charter bus or hotel stay is needed, boosters will cover the associated costs.
- Photographer payment: Board approved request to pay photographer on a game-by-game basis as the Varsity team advances in the postseason. (\$150/game) Discussed utilizing student photographers for next season.

Fundraising Committee Report

- **Sponsorship & Player Credit Update (as of 4/30/25)**
 - **Total Sponsorships:** 41 sponsors contributing **\$18,555.00** (\$500 outstanding from Fin Fit Life, Erin checking with Mancuso's to confirm securing of sponsorship) Send post season follow up email thanking sponsors for their contribution. Highlight what we were able to do with contributions so they may continue to sponsor for next season. Reach back out in January.
 - **Grand Slam:** 6 sponsors – \$6,000; **Homerun:** 15 sponsors – \$7,500; **Triple:** 9 sponsors – \$3,150; **Single:** 7 sponsors – \$1,225; **Family:** 2 sponsors – \$80; **Alumni:** 1 sponsor – \$500 and **Anonymous:** 1 sponsor – \$100
- **Player Credit Tracking:**
 - 15 packages sold (5 Grand Slam, 10 Homerun) – **\$10,000 raised**
 - Player credits used – **\$3,400**
 - **Net funds after credits: \$6,600**

9 of 10 seniors applied. Three recipients will be selected by the Awards Committee and coaching staff.


Winners will be announced and presented with checks at the June 17th banquet.

Location: The Camelot, Wexford


Key Information:
