- 2. Presidents Report
 - o 2024 Gear purchase
 - The Executive Board approved the purchase of the 2024 gear in late Spring/early Summer
 - We changed what was ordered this year based on feedback from the past years families and players.
 - Each players will receive less but higher quality Nike gear as opposed to lower quality inexpensive (BSN) gear
 - Apparel Store
 - Coaches Heck and Sabo are working on finalizing design options for the Board to select. The goal is to get store up and running by October 1st. We hope to have it open from 10/1-10/14 as to allow time for holiday arrival.
