- 1. Jaime Caro opened the meeting.
 - a. Jaime introduced the new board for the 2023/2024 school year.

- 2. Suzie Meier spoke about Booster Club Memberships

- 3. Suzie Meier spoke about Sponsorships
 - a. We are re-doing the sponsorship structure this year to include lower priced sponsorships
 - b. Sponsors are such an important part of our fundraising efforts.

- 4. Jacqui Niedzwiedz went through the budget.
 - a. Financial Reports can be found on the website at rousebaseball.com
 - b. Treasurer's report for August 2023
 - i. Income in August was \$907.39
 - ii. Expenses were \$13,156.08 (this included \$11,758 from last year's season that had not been paid yet)
 - iii. Beginning balance on August 1 was \$28,688.82
 - c. Expected Expenses report for 2023/2024
 - i. \$71,790 of expected expenses for this year
- 5. Jacqui Niedzwiedz spoke about Player Fees
 - a. We ask that each player pay a \$200 player fee for the first semester by the end of October.
 - b. These fees cover:
 - i. Baseballs
 - ii. Volt App
 - iii. 2 Caps
 - iv. Protein Shakes and Bars
 - v. Field Maintenance Costs
 - vi. General Program Costs
 - c. We will ask for a second semester fee to cover expenses in the second semester once tryouts are done in January.
- 6. Suzie Meier went through our fundraisers for this year.
 - a. We are planning for the following fundraisers for this year.

 - iii. Pancake Breakfast & Silent Auction

- 7. Alonzo Soliz spoke about our committees for this year and the volunteers we need.
 - a. We ask that everyone sign up for at least one committee to help us achieve everything we need to for this year.

- 8. Shannon Soliz spoke about concessions for this year as well as player meals.
 - a. Concessions are open for every home game during the spring season including scrimmages and tournaments.
 - i. We ask that every family volunteer in concessions at least 3 times during the season.
 - ii. Once the schedule for the season is released we will create a sign up form and give everyone 2 weeks to sign up for the 3 time slots they would like.
 - iii. After those two weeks, we will place anyone who hasn't signed up for 3 time slots into the remaining time slots that are still open.
 - b. Player Meals during District Games
 - i. Player meals are optional, but we encourage everyone to sign up for them as it is a guaranteed way your child will eat before games.
 - ii. We work to keep the costs as low as possible while still providing the boys with a good meal.
 - iii. The boys are fed before all week day games.
 - iv. The cost will be determined once we know the game schedule and have figured out how many meals will need to be provided.
 - v. We will ask for volunteers to help pick up the food once in a while and bring it to the boys.
- 9. Suzie Meier spoke about practice gear.

- a. Practice gear will be purchased through BSN again this year.
- b. The store should be live very soon and will be emailed out to everyone
- c. Each boy is asked to have 2 short sleeve shirts and one pair of shorts for practice.
- d. There will be additional items available if you wish to purchase them.
- 10. Suzie Meier spoke about communication.
 - a. We communicate with the parents using 3 avenues.

 - c. Team App This is our main form of communication so please be sure to download the Stack Team app and create an account. Look for Rouse Baseball and request access as a Parent/Guardian. Be sure to include your son's name! If you were on a team last year you do not need to re-join.

11. Coach's Corner - Coach Krempin

- a. Coach Krempin introduced himself and Coach Manny Perez.
 - i. Coach Perez is the new Varsity Assistant Coach.
 - ii. Coach Krempin and Coach Perez have been friends for a while.
 - iii. Coach Perez coached at Hayes before coming to Rouse.
- b. Snap Raise is under way
 - i. This is a big fundraiser for us
 - ii. All boys are asked to enter at least 20 email addresses

c. Fall Ball

- i. We have 18 seniors this year so most of the first Fall team is made up of seniors.
- ii. That team is in a league with the Round Rock schools
- iii. None of the other schools around have a second team besides us
 - iv. The second team will be made up of Juniors and Sophomores and possibly a few Freshmen.
 - v. Coach is working on picking up games for them to play.
 - vi. Fall Ball is played on Wednesdays until November.

d. Spring Tryouts

- i. Keeping around 60 kids from spring tryouts.
- ii. Tryouts are mid-January

- iii. During tryouts we measure velo, exit velo, how they field balls, how they hit and how they run.
- e. Bond Package
 - i. The earliest turf could be done is January.
 - ii. Possibility they could start in October and finish in January.
 - iii. This is not forsure though. Latest it could happen is they would start in June and install it over the summer
 - iv. The bond did not just cover turf. It also included netting behind home plate, a new 7 inning scoreboard, and possibly some work done with the cages and bullpens. We also might get a new sound system.
