Overview;

- Upcoming fundraisers: golf tournament and Snap Raise are critical for budget goals.

Financials & Budget Overview:

- October 2025 \$23805 opening cash balance, \$6517 in income, \$8267 in monthly expenses, leaving an ending cash balance of \$20114.

Fundraising

- Currently \$19,977 raised via Snap Raise, need to increase income, please share on social media for the final push. We have about 2 weeks left.

Golf Tournament Planning and Sponsorships ;

- Golf tournament requires minimum 25 teams to break even.
- Currently have 7-8 teams; need 15-17 more teams.
- Tournament is three weeks away; last meeting before the event.
- Promotion via flyers, social media, and neighborhood pages encouraged.
- Securing hole sponsors and team sign-ups is a priority. \$250 Hole sponsorships are pure profit. Please reach out to those you know who could become a hole sponsor. Goal is 36 = \$9000 profit for the program!!
- No season sponsorships have been received as of this date.

Coach Krempin's update

- Team development: focus on player training, speed, and skill progression.
- Started a six-week developmental program focused on speed, base running, and exit velocity.
- Implemented Overload/Underload training with goal: 10 players over 90 mph exit velocity.
- Pitchers on separate velocity plan; aim for 10–12 pitchers at 90 mph in pulldowns.
- Recent fall Varsity game: won 13–0 vs. Georgetown; strong pitching, opportunistic offense. JV Won game over Legacy Ranch. Trying to find additional JV games, but not many schools have a fall ball program.
- Testing and program evaluation scheduled for Thanksgiving break.
- Schedules for tournaments and spring are currently being worked on and will get posted when finalized.

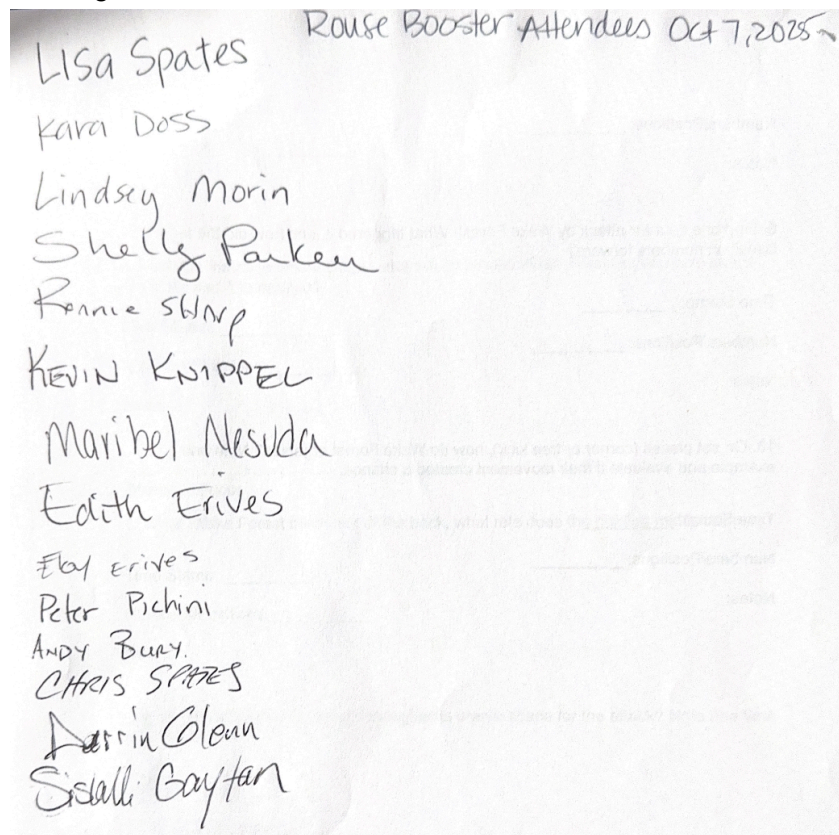
Treasurer Change Acknowledgement
