Extra innings: Games where scores are tied at the completion of 7 innings and No game follows or there is still time remaining in the scheduled game, and there is sufficient light and field availability, the tie will be resolved by Shootout rules, which are:

- A. Play 1 inning at a time, with the last 2 legal batters from the previous inning starting the new inning at first and second base.
- B. Each hitter comes to the plate with a 2-2 count. If the pitch is a called strike or missed on the swing, the batter is out; if the pitch is fouled off, the count remains 2-2; or the batter hits the ball fair. It takes 2 balls for the hitter to walk.
- C. Each team gets 3 outs. If the score remains tied after each team has batted, repeat the process until there is a winner or there is no more availability on the field due to lighting or field availability
