2026 FIELD GUIDELINES:

BALLWIN

- **PLEASE FREQUENT the CONCESSION STAND.**
- No outside food or drinks are allowed.
- Rainout number (636) 229-1110.
- Lights are automatic, on 30 minutes prior to sunset, off at 11:00 pm.
- Field does not get tarped after completed game.
- No batting practice allowed on field at any time.
- No soft toss into backstop/fence.
- No pets.
- Smoking is prohibited at Field and in dugouts, only in the Parking lot.

BLANCHETTE

- Rainout number (636) 944-6001.
- Lights are automatic, on 30 minutes prior to sunset, off at 11:00 pm.
- Field does not get tarped after completed game.
- No batting practice allowed on field at any time.
- No soft toss into backstop/fence.

BLAZIER

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Rainout number (618) 622-1439
- There are lightning detectors. If the teams hear a siren, get off the field. It is detected 0-8 miles away and will turn off 20 minutes after the last lightning was detected.
- Lights are automatic, on at sunset, off at 10:30 PM.
- You can use the batting cages that are located behind right field.
- No soft toss into backstop/fence.
- Pick up all trash out of both dugouts before leaving.
- No smoking.

BMAC

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED ON PITCHERS MOUND.**
- Rainout number (314) 500-0587.
- Lights are automatic, on 30 minutes prior to sunset, off at 11:30 pm.
- Field does not get tarped after completed game.
- Batting practice IS allowed on Field 1, 4 and 5.
- No soft toss into backstop/fence.
- Smoking is Prohibited at BMAC (with the exception of the Parking Lots).
- DO NOT USE THE FIELD TWO (2) BULLPEN No sunflower seeds, no chewing gum, no exceptions. \$250 violation fine.

BRENTWOOD

- Rainout hotline updated at 4:00 pm, (314) 963-8686.
- Lights turn on at sunset and turn off 15 minutes following scheduled end time.
- No soft toss into the backstop/fence.
- No glass bottles are permitted in the Park.
- Smoking is prohibited.
- Motorized vehicles are restricted to designated parking areas and roadways.
- All trash must be placed in proper receptacles.
- All dogs must be on a leash.

Car Shield Field

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Do Not enter onto the field until all previous users have exited the field.
- Tennis shoes, turf shoes, rubber spikes, and/or molded spikes are acceptable.
Molded spikes are the "preferred" cleat for the minor league players who frequent this field.
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Concession stand might be open.
- Lights are maintained by staff.
- Pick up all trash.
- No weighted balls thrown against fence.

Chesterfield Field

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- rainout number (636) 537-4770, updated at 3 pm.
- Lights are maintained by staff.
- Pick up all trash.
- No sunflower seeds.
- No soft toss.
- Smoking is prohibited
- Dogs must be on a leash.

DeSmet Field

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Pick up all trash
- No tobacco.
- No soft toss into the fence.

Ellisville Field

- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Concession stand might be open.
- Lights are maintained by staff.
- Pick up all trash.
- No pets allowed
- No outside food or drinks
- No smoking in Field area/field seating area

EUREKA FIELD

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Rainout number (636) 496-0030, or <https://link.edgepilot.com/s/7004d2e8/y3nbSz8yekCXOsZem1Ef9g?u=http://www.ra.inoutline.com/> and search Eureka.
- Games must be finished by no later than 10:00 pm.
- Outside food or drinks are allowed – no food/drink on the turf.
- Seeds of any kind are not allowed at the park.
- No soft toss or batting practice is allowed before games. (unless in the batting cage).
- No throwing into field fencing.
- Smoking is prohibited at field and in dugouts.
- Bullpens are available to use.
- Please ensure each dugout is clean after use.

GCS Ballpark

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED**
- Tennis shoes, turf shoes, rubber spikes, and/or molded spikes are acceptable. Molded spikes are the "preferred" cleat for the minor league players who frequent this field.
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Concession stand might be open.
- Lights are maintained by staff.

HEINE MEINE

- Alarm System in Restrooms will Automatically Arm at 11:00 PM
- **Managers LOCK THE RESTROOMS prior to 11:00 PM to Prevent Tripping of Alarm System!**
- Lights are on timer, computer controlled. Set to turn off at 11:00 PM.
- The concessions will not be open. Teams may bring in food and drinks.
- Bathrooms should be unlocked.
- A Key will be given to one of the Managers/Players to lock the bathrooms when finished.
- After the game, put the bases inside one of the bathrooms and lock the exterior doors.
- Place the key in the mail slot.
- If you encounter a problem, here is the chain of command for calls:

Hopkins Field

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Concession stand might be open.
- Lights are maintained by staff. If lights are not turned on, there is a key in the lockbox located on first base side down, next to the bullpen. See Reference Sheet for Code.
- Pick up all trash.

BIG HOPPE FIELD

- Rain Out Number (618) 691-8451.
- Concession stand will be open.
- Restrooms are available.
- Lights will be turned on and off by the concession stand staff.
- Clean up after each game.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed.

LAKE ST LOUIS/FOUNDERS FIELD

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED ON PITCHER'S MOUND.**
- The lights are on a timer and run from 7:15 PM - 11:00 PM.
- The concessions will not be open. Teams may bring in food and drinks.
- Field has an Artificial mound.
- Rainout number (636) 202-2027.
- See reference Sheet for Combination for dugout locks.

LONGACRE - LEGION

- Teams may bring in food and drinks.
- To unlock the field and turn on the lights you must obtain the keys which are located on the foul pole down the left field side of the field. See reference Sheet for Code.
- Turn off the lights and lock the gate(s) to the dugouts on your way out.
- Pick up all trash.
- Field has dirt mound again.

Maryville University

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Pick up all trash.

OZZIE'S FIELD A, B, C & D

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Rainout number is (636) 333-9900.
- Lights are turned on and off by recreation staff.
- No glass containers allowed.

PLUMMER FIELD

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED**
- Rainout number (since we are all turf it is unlikely we'll rainout), but if we have to cancel for severe weather, we will call you or you can give our office a call at 618-692-7538.
- Lights are set to set to sunset and 15 minutes after your scheduled game time, but we will have an onsite supervisor who can turn them on or reach out to us to extend the time if needed. Lights must be out by 11pm.
- All turf fields so no tarp is needed.
- Batting Practice- you are fee to warm-up and use the field as needed during your rental time.
- Soft toss- no soft toss into the fencing.
- No outside food or drinks allowed.
- No pets or dogs in the concourse area.
- No smoking at the park.
- No food allowed in dugouts.
- No seeds or gum allowed on the playing field.
- Renters (STL Baseball Forever) will be assessed a \$250 clean-up fee if seeds are found in or around the team's dugout.

SIUE FIELD

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED**
- Gum and sunflower seeds are 100% prohibited on this field.
- Concession stand will not be open.
- Lights are maintained by staff.
- Pick up all trash.

ST LOUIS UNIVERSITY – SLU

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.**
- Absolutely no seeds, tobacco, gum at the field
- Post-game dugout clean-up is mandatory.
- Parking is available in the SLU garage (Lindell Ave) for \$1 per hour (Credit Card only).

ST PETERS – REC PLEX

- Teams are allowed to drink beer up at the field area, in the parking lot is prohibited.
- Dispose of your trash in the trash cans.
- Upon completion of the last game place the tarp over the mound and the Batter's Box, close and lock all 4 dugout gates.
- The lights are on a timer and run from 7:00 PM - 10:30 PM.
- If you have lighting issues, call the Registration desk, 636-477-6600 (ext. 1400) or call Ranger (636) 278-2222 after 7 pm.
- No metal cleats in the batting cages.
- No glass allowed in the Park.
- No soft toss

WARRENTON ATHLETIC COMPLEX

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED**
- No seeds, shelled nuts, or gum
- There is no batting practice on the fields. Batting cages only
- No pets allowed (except for service animals)
- No alcohol to be brought into the park
- Rainout number (314) 904-3377
- Smoking is prohibited inside the quad. Please use the designated smoking area
- Gates to dugouts will open 1 hour before the 1st scheduled game
- Pitching mounds and bases will be set. Don't move them without staff approval.
- Please clean up dugouts and any trash that may be inside the quad.
- No skateboards or scooters inside the quad.

WESTHOFF

- Rainout number is (636) 333-9900
- Lights are turned on and off by recreation staff
- Field does not get tarped after completed game
- No glass containers allowed

WHITEY HERZOG

- **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED**

- Rain Out Hot Line (618) 233-7275
- Teams playing in the final game of the day are required to put the mats and tarp on the mound.
- Teams may bring in food and drinks.
- Lock the gates to the dugouts on your way out.
- Obtain the key to unlock the gates to the dugouts, unlock the key box attached to the main gate. The combination is on the Reference Sheet. To operate, enter the combination, slide the top black button down, the front panel will open, and the key will be inside. Just enter the combination again to relock.
- Lights are scheduled and will come on 30 min prior to sunset until 10:30 PM.
- The Bathroom locks are on a timer. Unlock at 9:00 AM relock at 10:30 PM, The code is on the Reference Sheet.
