12U Fall League 2025 Rules

- 1. A pitcher is allowed to pitch a maximum of 2 innings per game. Pitching mound visits will remain 2 coaches visits per inning with the second coaches visit to the same pitcher in the same inning resulting in a pitching change.
- 2. 12U will play 50/70 with live leads allowed.
- 3. 70-minute time limit per game. Drop dead at 70 minutes will be in effect for the league games with the exception of the end of season tournament. During drop dead if a batter is in the box before time expires then that batter will be allowed to finish his at bat. For the end of season tournament we will play 70 minutes (finish the inning) with no new inning to start with less than 5 minutes left in the game.
- 4. Run rules-15 after 3, 8 after 4 or 20 after any inning.
- 5. A team may bat round robin with free substitution allowed. Note: If a player is injured during the game and unable to bat then the team will not be penalized with an out.
- 6. Home team is responsible for keeping the official book and visiting team is responsible for keeping the scoreboard.
- 7. A courtesy runner may be used for both the pitcher and the catcher. The courtesy runner must be a player not currently in the line-up. If no players not currently in the line-up are available, the courtesy runner shall be the player making the last batted out.
 - 8. Each team will be responsible for furnishing their own baseballs to hit each game.
 - 9. A coin flip will determine home and visitor for league games. For the end of season tournament, the higher seed will have their choice of home or visitor.
- 10. League games may end in a tie.
 - 11. League standings determine seeding for the end of season tournament.
 - 1. W/L record
 - 2. Head to head
 - 3. Runs allowed
 - 4. Run scored
 - 5. Coin Toss
 - 12. A player is required to play a minimum of 2 league games in order to be eligible for the end of season tournament and be on roster of record.
 - 13. A league roster including the players name, age and date of birth is required to be submitted to keith.smith@mattr.com prior to the 2nd week of league play.
 - 14. This is not a USSSA sanctioned league however, USSSA age requirements apply.
- 15. Birth certificates ARE required for all players. These can be a paper copy or kept in electronic format. In the event of a question of player eligibility it is

the responsibility of the coach to provide proof of age by the means of a birth certificate at that time. Failure to provide proof will deem that player ineligible. Age requirements are as defined by USSSA official baseball National by-laws and rules-rule 3.0 individual player and team eligibility. August begins the 2025 Season therefore eligible players for fall baseball will be defined by their age on May 1st 2025.
