## **Details: Team Recognition and/or Achievement Awards**

Effective with the 2015 baseball season (May 01-2015) those Tecumseh Baseball Club Teams as follows: Midget (s), Juniors, Seniors and Old Timers that successfully compete in and WIN one (1) of the following categories during the calendar year:

- \*\*\* O.B.A. PLAYDOWNS OR CLASSIFICATION FINALS
- \*\*\* **O.B.A.** ELIMINATIONS
- \*\*\* CANADIANS or NATIONALS
- \*\*\* SHOWCASE or HIGH VISIBILITY U.S. or CANADIAN TOURNAMENTS

Will be entitled to participants awards , not exceeding twenty-eight (28) individuals (players and coaches) .A formal <u>Written Request</u> is to be submitted by the winning team manager to the T.B.C. Executive and Board of Directors identifying and describing the type of award(s) being considered , for review and approval or rejection . Individual awards are to be baseball oriented (bags, jerseys, jackets, trophies , wind-breakers etc.) **excluding jewelry** and are not to exceed <u>\$ 75.00 cd.</u> (including all applicable taxes) per individual X 28 = \$ 2100.00 .

A <u>Written Request</u> is to be submitted to the T.B.C. Executive and Board of Directors by the team manager within three (3) weeks or 21 days after the tournament, requesting that recognition and/or achievement awards be considered for the victorious participants in the <u>showcase or high visibility tournament</u>. Upon review of the request at the monthly meeting the T.B.C. Executive and/or Board of Directors will advise the team manager within one week if the request for the subject award(s) has been approved or rejected.

Effective with the 2015 season the maximum award( $\mathbf{s}$ ) per calendar year per individual will be one presentation not exceeding \$ 75.00 cd. (including all applicable taxes) . The maximum cost (\$75.00) is subject to review on a yearly basis (**December meeting**) by the T.B.C. Executive and Board of Directors for increase/decrease or carry-over to the following calendar year as governed by economics and T.B.C. budget feasibility and stability .
