IN A 10:00 A.M. START AT PEEKSKILL STADIUM, SUNDAY, THE METS 3 HIT THE GIANTS 12-0. THE

METS BUSTED THE GAME OPEN IN THE SEVENTH FOR THE 12-0 MERCY WIN.

THE GIANTS MUSTERED 3 HITS, A SINGLE BY VINCENT AMBROSELLI IN HIS FIRST AT BAT IN TWO YEARS, A DOUBLE BY ROB HORNE AND A SINGLE BY FRANK HAGAN. HAGAN AND HORNE'S HITS BOTH COMING IN THE 5TH. GIANTS STRUCK OUT 14 TIMES WITH NO WALKS.

GIANT AND LEAGUE ACE DEREK WILLIAMS VIRTUALLY MATCHED THE OPPOSING PITCHER FOR 5 INNINGS, GIVING UP JUST 1 EARNED RUN (4 IN TOTAL) FOR THE FIRST SIX INNINGS.

THE METS LED OFF THE BOTTOM OF THE FIRST WITH A WALK. DEREK THEN PROMPTLY PICKED HIM OFF. THE METS LATER SINGLED, STOLE 2ND AND SCORED ON A DOUBLE BY RAMOS FOR THE FIRST EARNED RUN. IN THE SECOND, FIRST RUNNER GOT ON VIA AN E5; DEREK PROMPTLY PICKED HIM OFF.

THE METS SCORED THEIR 2ND RUN IN THE 4TH ON A TWO-OUT ERROR ON AN E2 OVERTHROW TO THIRD ON A STEAL ATTEMPT. IN THE 6TH, TWO MORE GIANT ERRORS RESULTED IN 2 MORE UNEARNED RUNS. THE TRIBE DEFEATED THE CARDINALS (11-9) ON SUNDAY AT THE DOROTHY HAMILL SKATING RINK IN GREENWICH. THE CARDS PLATED THE 1ST RUN IN THE SCORELESS CONTEST IN THE BOTTOM OF THE 3RD ON AN RBI GROUND OUT BY EX-TRIBE MEMBER, BOB SMITH.

THE TRIBE COUNTERED WITH 2 RUNS IN THE TOP OF THE 4TH ON RBI SINGLES BY RAMSEY COLON AND PETE RODRIQUEZ. THE CARDS TIED THE GAME IN THE BOTTOM OF THE INNING ON A BOOMING RBI DOUBLE BY PATRICK HOLLAND. HOWEVER, THE TRIBE WAS ABLE TO ESCAPE FURTHER DAMAGE BY CUTTING HIM DOWN ATTEMPTING TO STRETCH IT TO A TRIPLE ON A NICE RELAY THROW.

THE TRIBE APPEARED TO BREAK THE GAME WIDE OPEN IN THE TOP OF THE 5TH WITH A 7 SEVEN SPOT, HELPED IN LARGE PART WITH SOME MISCUES BY THE CARDS. THE KEY HITS IN THE INNING WERE A PAIR OF 2 RUN SINGLES BY ANTHONY KAZMIERCZAK AND PAUL DIDOMENICO.

THE TRIBE EXTENDED THE LEAD TO (10-2) IN THE TOP OF THE 6TH ON AN RBI FC BY ANTHONY KAZMIERCZAK. THE TRIBE APPEARED TO BE ON THE VERGE OF COMPLETELY PUTTING THE GAME AWAY, BUT AGELESS VETERAN MIKE CHIANELLI CAME IN RELIEF TO SHUT THEM DOWN WITHOUT ANY FURTHER DAMAGE.

What appeared to be a comfortable W for the Tribe soon became anything but that in the bottom of the inning. Some very poor D by the Tribe opened the flood gates for a 6-run eruption by the Cards to cut the lead to (10-8). IN THE BOTTOM OF THE 9TH, THE CARDS GOT THEIR 1ST TWO RUNNERS ON BASE, BUT OVER AGGRESSIVE BASE RUNNING COST THEM AS THE LEAD RUNNER WAS CUT DOWN TRYING TO ADVANCE TO 3RD ON A PITCH IN THE DIRT WITH NO OUTS. THE TRIBE WAS ABLE TO RETIRE THE NEXT BATTER, BUT THEY THEN MADE THE RISKY MOVE OF INTENTIONALLY WALKING THE TYING RUN ON BASE. THE PLAYOFF FORMAT WILL CHANGE IN 2022. THE TWO-DIVISION FORMAT WILL REMAIN. HOWEVER, TEAMS FINISHING IN THE TOP SIX POSITIONS WILL COMPETE FOR THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AS OPPOSED TO THE TOP FOUR FINISHING TEAMS.

THE TEAMS WITH THE TWO BEST RECORDS IN THE UPPER DIVISION WILL RECEIVE A BYE WHEN PLAYOFFS BEGIN SEPTEMBER 25. THE NEXT FOUR TEAMS IN ORDER OF FINISH IN THE UPPER DIVISION (TEAMS THREE THROUGH SIX) WILL COMPETE IN A ONE GAME ELIMINATION, FIRST ROUND PLAYOFF.

THE SECOND ROUND, A BEST OF THREE SERIES, WILL THEN BEGIN ON OCTOBER 2 WITH TWO DOUBLEHEADERS BETWEEN THE WINNERS OF THE SINGLE ELIMINATION GAMES AND THE FIRST AND SECOND PLACE TEAMS THAT RECEIVED A BYE IN THE FIRST ROUND.
