# 2025 PLAYOFFS SET SEASON ENDS WITH TIGERS-GIANTS THRILLER

### GLANTS SQUEEK BY TIGERS IN RUMBROOK SEASON FINALE

RUMBROOK PARK, GREENBURGH, NEW YORK, AUGUST 24, 2025 BY: TONY MESSINA

THE WESTCHESTER GIANTS AND THE LEWISBORO TIGERS CLOSED THE SEASON WITH A THRILLING, BACK AND FORTH 10-9 GAME WHICH INCLUDED A RARELY USED MLB RULE — THE "A-ROD" RULE, VERBAL INTERFERENCE, GOOD CLUTCH HITTING, DESPITE THE SCORE, OUTSTANDING PTICHING ON BOTH SIDES, SOME DEFENSIVE GEMSAND SOME LAPSES. BUT THE SEE-SAW BACK AND FORTH, AS THE TEAMS EXCHANGED THE LEAD SEVERAL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE GAME.

THE TIGERS SEEMINGLY GOT OFF TO A GOOD START OFF GIANT STARTER AND ÅLL STAR PITCHER AND GUY, DERRICK WILLIAMS. JOHN TURNER SINGLED FOR THE FIRST HIT OF THE GAME, STOLE SECOND. NICK SOSA HIT A SLOW LINER DOWN THE THIRD BASE LINE, WHICH APPEARED TO THE THIRD BASE COACH, TONY MESSINA, TO BE GOING FOUL. TURNER TURNED IT ON COMING AROUND THIRD AND IN AN EFFORT TO SLOW HIM WITHOUT HIM TRYING TO SUDDENLY STOP, MESSINA COMMITED THE "VERBAL ITERFERENCE" YELLING TO TURNER, FOUL BALL, FOUL BALL, WHEN THE BALL FELL INCHES FAIR. FOR

A SECOND OR TWO, ALL ACTION STOPPED. MESSINA WAIVED TURNER IN, BUT A MOMENT OF CONFUSION FOLLWED. THE GIANTS ASKING WHO CALLED "FOUL" AND THE SECOND BASE UMPIRE SAYING "NOT ME." THE UMPIRE IMMEDIATELY HUDDLED AND GOT THE CALL WRITE. THE RUN DID NOT COUNT AND AN OUT WAS DECLARED, THE THIRD OUT OF THE INNING.

THE GIANTS JUMPED OUT TO A 1-0 LEAD IN THE FIRST ON HITS BY PANABIANCO AND GARCIA WITH A STOLEN BASE INBETWEEN.

THE TIGERS TIED IT IN THE BOTTOM OF THE THIRD ON A WALK TO LEADOFF HITTER DOMINGUEZ, AN ERROR AND A FIELDER'S CHOICE AND A SINGLE BY KEITH GUERTON.

In the third, the Tigers scored one after a Leadoff single by Sosa followed by an RBI single off catcher Kris Macrohon's bat.

Demian Domingez came through again driving home Macrohon, giving the Tigers a 3-1 edge.

THE GIANTS SCORED ONE IN THE BOTTOM OF THE THIRD AFTER HITS BY GOODFLIESH, RIAVE AND GARCIA. IN THE BOTTOM OF THE FOURTH, THE GIANTS WERE HANDED TWO AS THE TIGERS SUFFERED THROUGH A TOTAL DEFENSIVE LAPSE FOR THE HALF INNING, ALLOWING TWO UNEARNED RUNS AND HANDING THE G-MEN A 4-3 LEAD.

THE TIGERS CAME BACK IN THE TOP OF THE FIFTH, SCORING ONE AFTER ONE OUT SINGLES BY TODD HAPIUK AND RITELL AND A FIELDER'S CHOICE BY GUERTON.

THE G-MEN CAME STORMING BACK TO A 6-4
LEAD IN THE BOTTOM HALF, AFTER A LEADOFF HIT
BY PANABIANCO AND A STOLEN BASE, A SINGLE BY
GROTZER AND A TIGER MISCUE, A SINGLE BY
GARCIA AND WALK TO BROLIN, A FIELDER'S CHOICE
AND A BASES LOADED WALK TO FRANK HAGAN.

In the top of the sixth, it was the Tigers' turn. Sosa led off with a single, followed by Eric Lynch reaching base on an error and Messina reaching on a fielder's choice. Jarvis Wilson drove in the run with his first hit of the afternoon and Williams pitched out of the Jam Leaving the bases loaded retirng Frankie Rivera on a grounder to second.

SOSA, WITH THE SCORE 6-5 GIANTS,
TOUGHENED IN THE BOTTOM OF THE SIXTH, STRIKING
OUT TWO GIANTS AND AFTER A SINGLE BY RIAVE,
HIS SECOND OF WHAT WOULD BE A THREE HIT DAY,
AND ANOTHER ERROR BY THE TIGER DEFENSE, SOSA
RETIRED GROTZER ON A SOFT LINER TO SECOND.

IN THE SEVENTH, THE TIGERS OFFENSE BROKE OUT. RITELL LED THE INNING WITH HIS THIRD HIT OF THE DAY FOLLOWED BY GUERTON'S SECOND HIT ON THE DAY. TURNER DROVE IN RITELL ON A FIELDER'S CHOICE, SOSA SINGLED IN A RUN WITH HIS THIRD OF FOUR HITS FOR THE DAY, MACROHON SINGLED AND MESSINA DROVE IN ANOTHER WITH A SINGLE. THE TIGERS SCORED FOUR ALL TOLLED, TAKING A 9-6 LEAD INTO THE BOTTOM OF THE SEVENTH.

SOSA CAME OUT FOR THE SEVENTH. BUT HE TIRED. GARCIA LED WITH A DOUBLE, BROLIN, GIUENSTRASS AND SCOVETTI EACH SINGLED, SCOVETTI DRIVING HOME 2 AND IN A FLASH, THE TIGER LEAD WAS GONE AND THE G-MEN WENT UP 10-9, WHICH WAS THE FINAL. WHILE THE CLUBS RATTLED THEIR BATS OVER THE LAST INNING AND HALF, TURNER FOR THE TIGERS AND SCOTTIE MUNZ FOR THE GIANTS ENDED ALL SCORING.

A COMPETITYE, OVERALL WELL-PLAYED GAME.

COMMISSIONER HAGAN ADDRESSED THE TIGERS AFTER THE GAME, ENCOURAGING THEM AND EXPRESSING HIS RECOGNITION OF THEIR SEASON IMPROVEMENT AND GRIT — NOT WALKING AWAY FROM ANY CONTEST; TRYNG THEIR BEST AND DOING ALL THEY COULD TO CONTINUE TO IMPROVE. THE TIGERS WERE VERY GRATEFUL TO THE COMMISH FOR THE ENCOURAGEMENT — BUT STILL HOPE TO SEE THE GIANTS IN THE PLAYOFFS — AND TAKE TWO OF THREE!
