DECANDIDO CLUTCH AGAIN

PHIL DECANDIDO'S BIG DAY ON DEFENSE AND OFFENSE LEAD UNDEFEATED PIPELAYERS OVER REDS

THE PELHAM PIPELAYERS WERE TRIUMPHANT OVER THE REDS 5-4 ON A RAINY FRIDAY NIGHT, UNDER THE LIGHTS AT GLOVER FIELD IN PELHAM.

THE REDS GOT ON THE BOARD IN THE BOTTOM OF THE FIRST INNING AFTER #23 SINGLED, AND #16 WALKED, EACH SCORING ONE RUN.

PELHAM FLIPPED THE GAME ON ITS HEAD IN THE TOP OF THE FIFTH, SCORING FIVE RUNS ON FIVE HITS TO TAKE A 5-3 LEAD. THE BIGGEST BLOW IN THE INNING WAS A DOUBLE BY PHIL DECANDIDO THAT DROVE IN TWO.

MIKE TURSELLI EARNED THE WIN FOR PELHAM, IMPROVING HIS RECORD TO 5-0 ON THE SEASON. TURSELLI SURRENDERED FOUR HITS AND FOUR RUNS (THREE EARNED) OVER SIX INNINGS, STRIKING OUT EIGHT. PEARLMAN TOOK THE LOSS FOR THE REDS, GOING SIX AND ONE-THIRD INNINGS, ALLOWING FIVE RUNS (FOUR EARNED) ON SEVEN HITS, WHILE STRIKING OUT SEVEN.

DECANDIDO LED THE PIPELAYERS WITH TWO

RBI. THE CENTER FIELDER WENT 1-FOR-3 ON THE DAY. GREG SILVER WENT 2-FOR-4 AT THE PLATE TO LEAD PELHAM PIPELAYERS IN HITS. BIG STICK RICK CONTINUED HIS ASSAULT ON OPPOSING PITCHERS AND NOW HAS 12 HITS ON THE SEASON.

#23, #21, #12, AND #5 EACH COLLECTED ONE HIT FOR REDS. #23, #24, AND #16 EACH DROVE IN ONE RUN FOR REDS. #23 STOLE THREE BASES.

THE REDS THREATENED IN THE BOTTOM OF THE 7TH, BUT WERE DETERRED WHEN DECANDIDO MADE THE PLAY OF THE GAME, TRACKING DOWN A DEEP FLY TO THE GAP AND SECURED THE WIN FOR PELHAM.

PELHAM IMPROVED TO 5-0 IN ITS INAUGURAL SEASON. THEIR NEXT SCHEDULED GAME IS AGAINST THE ORIOLES ON JUNE 9.

LEWISBORO THUNDER EARNS INAUGURAL WIN

THE LEWISBORO THUNDER CELEBRATED THEIR FIRST VICTORY BY DEFEATING THE TIGERS 15-7 ON SUNDAY AT FOX VALLEY PARK.

STEVEN GRSKOVIC HAD A GAME, GOING THREE-FOR-FOUR WITH SINGLES IN THE THIRD, SEVENTH, AND EIGHTH INNINGS. DESPITE BEING THE AWAY TEAM ON THEIR HOME FIELD, THE THUNDER OVERCAME AN EARLY DEFICIT.

THE TIGERS TOOK AN EARLY LEAD IN THE BOTTOM OF THE FIRST INNING. AFTER HEITMAN SINGLED TO SCORE ONE RUN, TWO ADDITIONAL

RUNS WOULD SCORE LATER, GIVING THE TIGERS A 3-0 LEAD.

THE THUNDER TIED THE GAME IN THE TOP OF THE SIXTH, THANKS TO AN ERROR AND A SINGLE BY TODD OZARIAN. THEY TOOK THE LEAD IN THE TOP OF THE SEVENTH INNING AND NEVER LOOKED BACK. CHRIS LOPEZ AND GRSKOVIC EACH SINGLED, PAUL KUSZYNSKI SCORED AFTER TAGGING UP, AND JOHN TURNER ADDED A SINGLE, EACH DRIVING IN A RUN.

THE THUNDER'S OFFENSE EXPLODED IN THE TOP OF THE EIGHTH INNING WITH FIVE RUNS ON FIVE HITS. LOPEZ, KUSZYNSKI, AND GRSKOVIC EACH SINGLED TO DRIVE IN A RUN, WHILE CHRIS WHITE'S SINGLE BROUGHT IN TWO MORE RUNS.

GRSKOVIC EARNED THE WIN BY PITCHING SEVEN INNINGS, ALLOWING TEN HITS AND FIVE RUNS (THREE EARNED), STRIKING OUT FIVE, AND WALKING THREE. TURNER PROVIDED EFFECTIVE RELIEF FOR THE THUNDER IN THE 8TH AND 9TH.

FAIRWEATHER STARTED FOR THE TIGERS, ALLOWING NINE HITS AND SIX RUNS (THREE EARNED) OVER SIX AND ONE-THIRD INNINGS, STRIKING OUT ONE AND WALKING FOUR.
