Our baseball program must sell a minimum number of vouchers from the Rockies, and the expectation is that each player sells at least 20 vouchers (families with two players in the program are expected to sell 30 vouchers). Players who sell above 20 vouchers will receive \$5.00 credit per voucher (in excess of the 20 vouchers) towards their GHS Baseball player account. Please consider selling vouchers to your family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, and/or local businesses. Or, they make great holiday gifts.

Selling Rockies tickets affords Grandview High School baseball the opportunity to play a game on Coors Field. That game is a memorable experience for our players, and any player who has sold 20+ vouchers by the March deadline will be eligible to be excused from classes that day to attend the game and support our Wolves.
