Current:

9 game regular season with 4 teams advancing to the playoffs.

Proposal:

- Move back to an 8 game regular season with 4 teams advancing to the playoffs.
- Higher seed will host the semifinals, with the championship hosted by ASAA at the host site.
- This will align with DI and DIII
- This will move our state championship game to the same weekend as the DIII State Championship as in previous seasons.
- This will effectively fix the scheduling issues that were brought up this past year by ASAA
 - West valley
 - Palmer and SoHi
 - Etc.
- This will allow athletes to move into hockey and wrestling, one more week into the season that is already overlapping quite a bit.

Reduction in the Required number of practices

Current:

10 days of practice is required before playing in a game.

Proposal A:

• Reduce the required number of practices to 5 days for all ASAA Activities.

Proposal B:

- Reduce the required number of practices to 5 days for non-contact sports.
 - Would not include Football, Wrestling and Hockey.

Rationale-

- The purpose of the 10 days of practice is to ensure that athletes are in shape and ready to go to reduce the chance of injury. A majority of our athletes are already participating in pre-season or a comp season prior to the start of the high school activity and are ready to go. I know that not all high school participants will come in day 1 having participated in preseason, camp or comp., but a majority will so I feel the rule should be made for the majority. For example, I always find it hard to hold a hockey kid out of the first game because he has 7 days of high school practice but he has been practicing and playing comp. games for 2 months.
- During covid, we were able to reduce the requirement to 5 days, if it was safe then, why wouldn't it be safe now.
- It will increase participation in the first event of each season as more kids will be eligible.
- May lead to more flexibility in the schedule with an extra week to play games.
- School Districts/Coaches could still require more than 5 days if they feel it is necessary.
- We have allowed 5 day practice waivers when sports overlap.
