Governing Rules

Baseball competition in the Railbelt Conference will follow the guidelines established by the NFHS rule book and all applicable rules and regulations established by ASAA, Region 3 and Region 6.

Season

ASAA will determine the baseball season.

Scheduling

The conference schedule will consist of each team playing two games against all teams in the conference (double headers with JV game). Odd years, Valley will host and even years, Fairbanks will host regular season games. Teams will also have the option of playing additional non-conference games against each other. If playing more than 2 games, the schools involved need to identify the 2 conference games prior to the start of the season.

State Qualifying Process

The top two Railbelt Conference teams from the Region Tournament will qualify. The Region Tournament Champion will be the number 1 seed and the runner up will be the number 2 seed. Fairbanks will host odd years & Valley even years.

- 1- Best Record in conference
- 2- Head to Head
- 3- Head to Head non-conference games
- 4- Fewest runs allowed in conference games
- 5- Coin Toss

Trophies & Awards

Trophies and awards will be purchased by the host school. 1st Place- Trophy, 18 Individual. medals for the 1st place team. 10 All-conference medals, 1 MVP Award, 8 Good Sport Awards.

All-Conference Team Selection

- 1. Head coaches will nominate up to 5 players from their team for consideration. These nominations need to be emailed to the host school no later than 3 days before the meeting
- 2. Coaches will select the best 11 best players regardless of year in school or team record.
- 3. There will be no allocation of all conference selection spots for each school. There could be a chance where a school will have no all-conference players selected.
- 4. Coaches are encouraged to nominate only those worthy of recognition.
- 5. Additional nominations will not be accepted at the conference meeting.
- 6. Coaches cannot vote for their own players.

Voting will be transparent for all other coaches to see.

Coach of the Year: A coach of the year will be voted on at the coaches meeting. Coaches can not vote for themselves.

Good sport Team: A good sport team will be selected. Each school will nominate 1 individual from their team.

All ties will be broken by the board of control.

During the coaches meeting, a discussion should be facilitated by the host school regarding any concerns or changes needed to the bylaws. These concerns will then be presented at the next region meeting.
