Please do not have parents or players at the check-in table. If you have an outstanding balance, you can pay it when you check in, and turn in player waiver sheets. At this time the coach will receive t-shirts and a coaches shirts. T-shirt policy is spelled out below.

3) Parking

At Colorado Mines: Parking is FREE after 5pm on Friday and FREE Saturday and Sunday on Campus. Please be aware that they will charge for parking before 5pm on Friday.

4) T-shirt policy

Once checked-in at the registration table, **Shirts and Coaches Shirts will only be given to the coach.**

5) Format/Number of Games

Each team will play a minimum of **five games**.

We will have the following divisions: Varsity, Small School Varsity, Junior Varsity, Sophomore and Freshmen. Some teams will play 3 pool play games; others will play 4 pool play games. However, every team will get *at least* five games.

A few notes on scheduling:

- We made every attempt to satisfy the time requests of specific teams. **This came above all.**
- Every effort was made to keep teams from the same league playing each other.
- We wanted to ensure that two teams from the same school wouldn't play each other in the tournament.

****Understand that schedule changes week of tournament due to last minute time requests will not be made. ****

6) Officiating

We take pride in having the best officiated team camp.

For this weekend, Colorado Alliance of Basketball Officials will oversee our officiating.

- ***If you have a problem with officiating during the tournament, please see the Tournament Director before confronting the official.***
- ***Parents with officiating & scorekeeping concerns will be directed to their respective Coach.***
- ***Parents who confront officials will be asked to leave the gym by the tournament director.***

If a parent is being disrespectful to the officials or opposing team, officials are instructed to first ask the HEAD COACH of the team to handle the issue. If it does not get handled, and the actions continue, the parent(s) will be escorted from the gym.

We hate to spend time on this, but please manage your parents the best you can so the officials and tournament directors do not have to.

7) What to bring

- Reversible jerseys (light and dark) that include the player's numbers. Home team wears light color.
- Player Waivers for each player participating. **Please make sure your players have included their insurance information.**
- Entry fee balance if it has not already been paid. Please call if you need your balance.
- Coaches will be responsible for bringing their own basketballs.

8) Late Start/Forfeit Policy

- Teams may start a game with 4 players. If a team has 4 players and it is game time, they **MUST** start.
- If a team is running late, it will be considered a forfeit if they arrive 15min after game time.
- All issues involving starting late will be handled by the tournament director
