Make-up Parent Meetings:

Player Fee Deposits are due:

As we shared in the previous Newsletter, and at the November Parent meetings, we still have nearly \$2000 in uncollected player fees from the fall season and another \$2000 in uncollected fees from the Spring/Summer. As you can imagine this puts an incredible strain on our already tight budget. We can not sustain this. So for this season, and all subsequent seasons, we will be collecting all player fees before players are allowed to participate in events. Initial player deposits were due in the Fall and 2nd payments were due last week. Many still have not paid. If you have not already made these payments, we need you to do so this week, or bring it with you to the Parent meeting. For the Spring/Summer season \$250 deposits were due Nov 15th, 2nd payments by Jan 1st, 3rd Payments by Feb 15th, and Final payments by March 15th so that all balances are paid by the time of our 1st event.
