All facilities require following the same basic rules.

Schools are NOT REQUIRED to provide us with access. It is a privilege, and as such we are responsible for adhering.

Facility access and 'vacancies'

Doors are not open for general access. Custodians open for the first group to arrive, and a door buzzer is placed on the outside entryway. Later arrivals must hit the buzzer, and someone in the vicinity of the receiver when it rings, will come open.

We cannot have 'vacancies' in our schedules. If you are the 11am team, and you decide to cancel a practice, we need to alert the team before and after you, so that someone can stay or come early. **If we leave the gym empty, normally the staff think we are done for the day and they will lock up.** As such all teams after that time will not be able to have practice.

Food and drink are not permitted in ANY gym area.

They are required to be kept in specified hallways outside of each gym. These beverage areas will vary by school.

There should be no children (players, siblings, friends) congregating in the halls. Unless it is a team huddle or they are accessing water bottles, there is no need for anyone to be in the halls. We are also not permitted to **bounce balls in the hallway, nor touch anything that does not belong to us.**

End of Day – Closing and Clean-Up

The last two (2) teams each day are responsible for closing procedures.

This could include any of the following:

- Safely returning scorekeeping devices to their storage bags
 - Packing up all game and scoring materials into the provided tubs.
 - Pushing in bleachers
 - Stacking chairs
 - Collecting any equipment used and returning to its proper area.
 - Collecting any trash and disposing.
 - Returning the doorbell and wall receiver to the staff on duty OR to their interior holding location



Game Management


Game management contents will exist only for facilities in which games are played.
