## **Parents and Spectators Code of Conduct**

### **Parents and Spectators:**

- **Shall be positive role models for the players**
- **Shall display, and instill in all players, the principals of good sportsmanship and team play**
- **Shall conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players**
- **Shall do their best to make this a positive experience for the players**
- **Shall notify the coaches as soon as possible of any conflicts with games and practices**
- **Shall treat all players, coaches, league officials and referees fairly and with respect**
- **Shall respect the opponent and avoid any confrontations with opposing players, coaches and spectators**
- **Shall inform the coach or league official of any issue or ailment that may affect the safety of their child**
- **Shall comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policies and procedures set forth by TYB**
- **Shall be drug and alcohol free while at any TYB sponsored events (practices, games, fund raisers, parties, etc)**

**All violations of the Code of Conduct shall be addressed on an individual basis. TYB feels strongly about enforcing the principles of the Code of Conduct and violators shall be dealt with appropriately.**

**Failure to abide by the rules and guidelines of TYB's Code of Conduct, could make that individual subject to disciplinary action that could include, but not limited to:**

**Verbal/ Written warning from Head Coach, TYB Board and/or MetroWest Board which could include Game Suspension or Season Suspension depending on violation of the Code.**

**First Technical – Game Suspension (next game)**

**Second Technical – 2 Game Suspension (next 2 Games)**

**Third Technical - Season suspension (removal from TYB)**
